Our Guaranteed Placement Program (GPP) through the Insalaco Center for Career Development will also back that up by offering students a paid internship in their field if they are not employed or in graduate school within six months of graduation*.

Because four out of five Misericordia students participate in an internship, field work, or a clinical experience before they graduate, they know exactly what to expect. This is what makes our students stand-out from the rest of the competition and get the jobs.

From internships and practica to research and study abroad opportunities, more than half of our students have completed one or more professional experiences by their senior year.
