

 - Official vs. Unofficial
- CWU (for student I.D. call 509.963.3001)

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Letters of Recommendation

Students should complete the Senior Information Packet (Senior ADV Edmodo Page)

- Provides details on test scores, academic potential, academic & personal interests, obstacles, etc.
 - Provide minimum 2-weeks
- Select people who are familiar with potential and achievements; teachers in an academic subject
