SENIOR CLASS PRIVILEGES

2019-2020

The following sections of the *Student & Parent Handbook 2019-2020* are amended in honor of the Senior Class to include the following privileges:

“Daily Schedule” (*Student & Parent Handbook 2019-2020*, p. 8)

- The Senior Class may be excused from Chapel first.
- The Senior Class Table(s) in the dining hall is the table(s) in front of the wall of windows.

“Automobiles-Leaves” (*Student & Parent Handbook 2019-2020*, pp. 23-25)

- Senior Student-Drivers (i.e. Boarders) may have unlimited weekend leaves provided they have no missing work, are in good academic standing, are in good behavioral standing, etc.
- Senior Student-Drivers (i.e. Day Students & Boarders) may sign-out during a Free-Period to go to downtown Bell Buckle or Shelbyville *on the appropriate day provided parental permission is filed with the Dean of Students Office*, they have no missing work, are in good academic standing, are in good behavioral standing, etc.

“Ride Share Policy” (*Student & Parent Handbook 2019-2020*, p. 46)

- Seniors (i.e. Boarders) may exercise the privilege of using “Uber and Lyft” on the weekends according to what is stated in the handbook.

“Dress and Appearance” (*Student & Parent Handbook 2019-2020*, pp. 27-31)

- Seniors may wear college sweatshirts/hoodies over school attire.
- Seniors may wear Senior Blazers on Fridays with casual dress that honors school values, with emphasis on the following:
 - “Style of dress is to be traditional, modest, and appropriate for the occasion.
 - Appearance, to include clothing, is to be wholesome, neat, and clean.”
- Seniors may wear school polos on Wednesdays *after Spring Break* unless instructed to be in Formal dress due to a special schedule, guest(s), etc.

“Study Hours” (*Student & Parent Handbook 2019-2020*, p. 43)

- Seniors (i.e. Boarders) may keep their “cell/smart devices” during Study Hours provided they have no missing work, are in good academic standing, are in good behavioral standing, etc.

Miscellaneous

- The Senior Class may have a Skip Day TBD and contingent upon proper planning and approval by the school, and timely communication with the Dean of Students Office.
