Drop Off/Pick Up

Please help make dropping off and picking up students a better experience by following these few guidelines:

- ◆ Pull all the way forward when dropping off. A few extra steps for students won't hurt them.
- ◆ Drop off and pick up only at the curb.
- ◆ Don't use the upper parking lot to drop off or pick up students.
- ◆ Only turn right onto Center Street when exiting the parking lot.
- ◆ Consider dropping off and picking students up at the LDS church on Orchard Drive and have the students cross with the crossing guard.
