

AB 705

- Bill signed by the Governor that took effect in January 2018
- Community colleges are to maximize the probability that a student will enter and complete transfer-level coursework in English and Math within a one-year timeframe
- Required to use multiple measures in determining course placement, High School coursework, GPA, and grades
- Prohibited from requiring students to take a prerequisite English or Math course unless they are highly unlikely to succeed in a transfer-level course without it



AB 705 at Foothill College

Foothill's Response to AB 705:

- Math 180: Prepares students for Statistics
- MPS Math 10: Embedded tutoring & counseling
- Math 48A + 248A: Pre-Calculus 1 + Co-requisite
- English 1S & 1T (Engl 1A): 2 quarter sequence Comp & Reading courses + Co-requisite
- English 1A + Co-requisite: Support course

All Open Access Courses



DRC Support Services per AB 705

- In-house tutoring for Algebra, Khan Academy for guided practice
- Collaborating with Pass the Torch and STEM Center for English and Math Student/Tutor Matching
- Working to extend tutoring sessions for higher level Math



Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

Guaranteed admission to 1 UC campus and to specific major

6 of 9 UC's participate in TAG

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be CCC transfer student with 1/2 of units completed at CCC
- Requires Junior Level Transfer Standing
- 60/90 semester/quarter units required, includes GE and Major Prep
- 7 Course Pattern 2 English Composition, 1 Math, and 4 in 2 different areas (Arts & Humanities, Social and & Behavioral Sciences, Biological & Physical Sciences)
- Minimum GPA between 2.7 and 3.4, varies by campus and major



Our Commitment to Provide Service


