

Germany 2021

Come explore beautiful Germany during Webb's spring break March 27-April 4, 2021!

This tour starts at the remnants of the Berlin Wall, a guarded concrete barrier that physically and psychologically separated East and West Berlin from 1961-1989. We'll explore the expansive German countryside that inspired Beethoven to write his nine symphonies. We'll also see the fairytale-inspiring Neuschwanstein Castle, built by shy King Ludwig II in order to withdraw from public life. We'll explore Munich in depth, visiting the Documentation Center, which focuses on the history and consequences of the Nazi regime. We will also visit the Dachau Concentration camp, exploring one of the darkest periods in human history. Gain a deeper understanding of German culture as you explore history and modern life in Berlin, Munich and some of its smaller cities that make Germany the powerhouse it is today.
