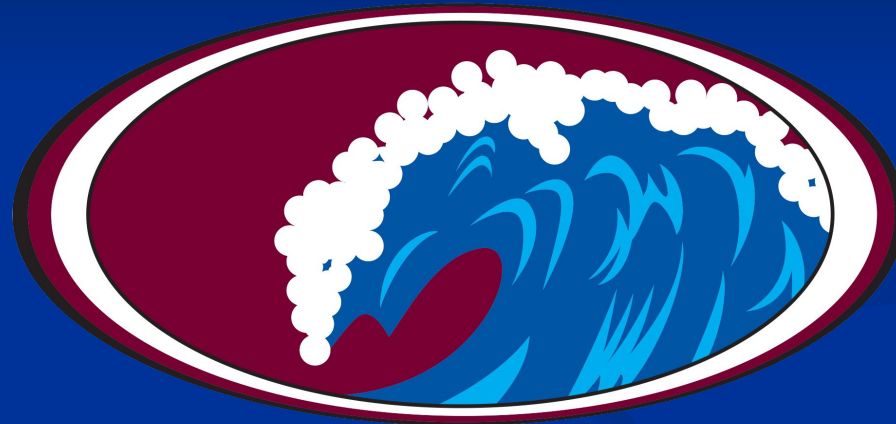

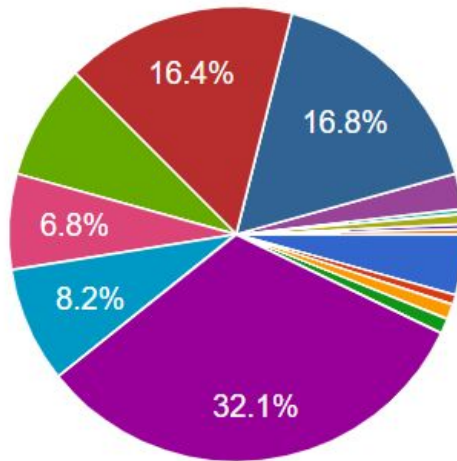

- Visit colleges before and after acceptance
- Research programs within the colleges: think long term!

Important Application Tips

- Print a copy of each essay and write in advance
- Watch for errors (parents: double check!)
- Check deadlines often
- Check school specific requirements
 - Interviews
 - Essays/Supplements/Auditions/Portfolios
- Establish an appropriate email address/check it!
- Check your college portal once applied
- When in doubt, call the college!

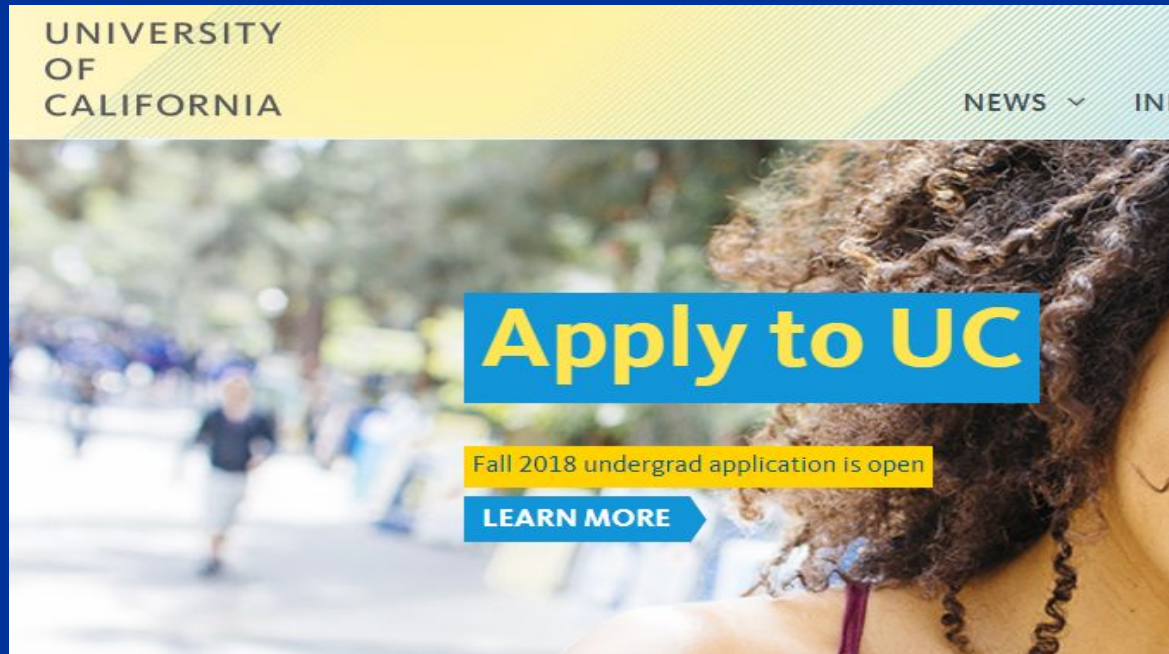

- Regular Decision
deadlines vary
admit, deny, waitlist
- Rolling Admission
Takes applications as they come to fill class

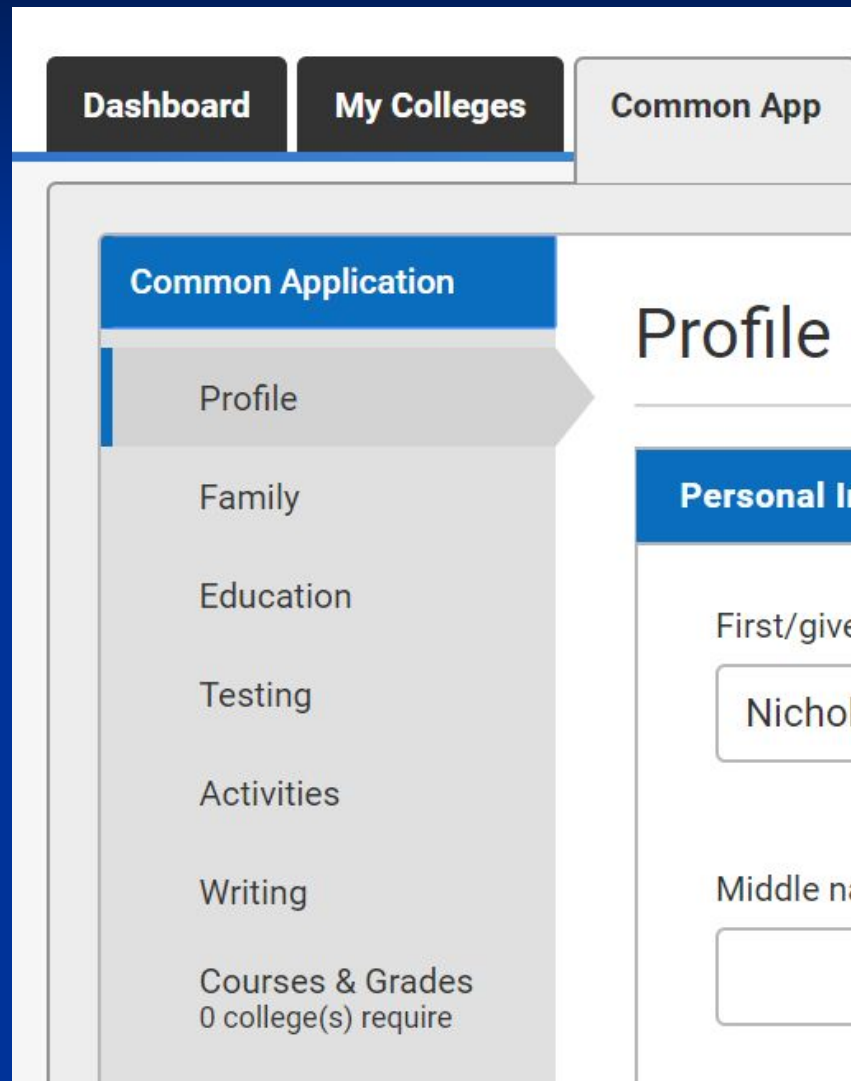

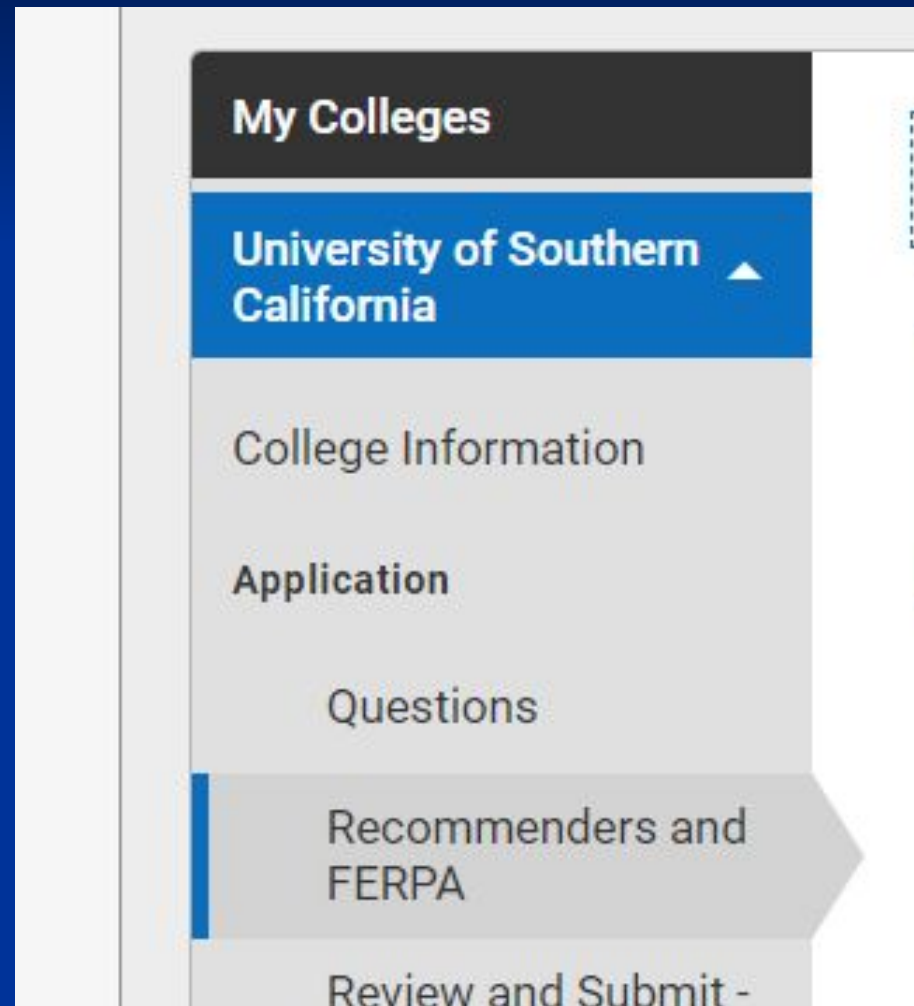

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

Counselor Letter of Recommendation

- Complete senior student/parent questionnaire
- Request counselor as recommender
- Send all required documents in one email:
 - **Resume**
 - **Senior Student/Parent Questionnaire**
 - **College Essay**
- See Mrs. Palino in the front office for appt

**MUST BE AT LEAST 2 WEEKS IN
ADVANCE**

Requesting a Counselor Letter

- Early Action/Early Decision/Rolling:
And highly recruited athletes
 - September 9th -November 1st
- Regular Decision:
 - November 1st and Ongoing

Teacher Letter of Recommendation

- ★ Purpose: Spotlight classroom accomplishments
 - Preferably junior year academic teacher
 - Check colleges for specific requirements
 - Send Teacher LOR packet
 - Send a thank you card! 😊

COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Community College

- 32% of LBHS students attend
- IVC Matriculation Workshops at LBHS - Senior Seminar 10/16
- October 1 start applying
 - Transfer Admission Guarantee
 - Transcript Placement/assessment
- Can attend local community college of intended university and transfer too!

How to Apply: CC Matriculation

■ Step 1: Orientation

- Completed online after submit application
- Introduced to college programs/policies

■ Step 2: Assessment & Placement

- Based on LBHS Transcript
- May take an assessment test to improve placement

■ Step 3: Advisement

- View test results and form educational plan

■ Step 4: First semester Plan

College Visits in the CCC

- Insider view of the college and flavor of school
- College rep can “put a face with a name”
- Often the rep is admissions officer for our region
- Chance for students to ask direct questions
- Reps offer contact information and assistance
- Demonstrated interest!

Financial Aid In a Nutshell

- FAFSA, apply as of Oct. 1st
- Student Aid Report (SAR) showing your Expected Family Contribution (EFC)
- EFC forwarded to colleges who will then determine a financial aid package
 - Combination of grants, loans and work-study.
- The EFC is the same regardless of the cost of the college, but the packages received from each college will vary

More Financial Aid

- CSS Profile - College Scholarship Search Profile is required by approximately 200 private colleges and universities
 - File in October!
- Families can get an estimate of their EFC at any time
 - Net Price Calculator on every institution website
 - FAFSA 4Caster at www.FederalStudentAid.ed.gov

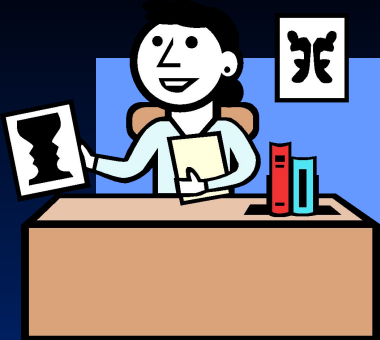
