## HHS Music Attire

The use of the Harrison Central School District's Music Attire is a privilege extended to students for concerts both within and outside of school, as needed. The District's Music Attire is provided to support students in achieving a professional presentation for all public performances for which they are required to participate in.

All Music Attire is the property of the Harrison Central School District, and is provided to students for the entire school year. Prior to the winter concert, music teachers will disseminate attire to each student, who will use the attire for performances as directed by the teacher. After the spring concert, students will be required to return their attire to their music teacher in its entirety. Families may use their discretion as to whether or not to get their attire professionally dry cleaned in between performances. All Music Attire will be professionally dry cleaned by the district when returned in the spring for the following school year.

The following components comprise the Music Attire, and students are <u>financially responsible</u> for <u>each</u> <u>part</u> of the attire they are given:

Black Dress	\$59.00
Black Tuxedo Jacket	\$56.00
Black Tuxedo Pants	\$25.00
White Tuxedo Button-down Shirt	\$14.00
Black cummerbund	\$7.50
Black Bow Tie	\$3.00

Students who wear the Black Tuxedo will be required to provide their own **black socks and black dress shoes**. Likewise, students who wear the Black Dress will be required to provide their own **black shoes**.

With the privilege of utilizing the District-owned Music Attire comes responsibility, and as a condition of use, students and parents must sign this contract and consent form, and agree to and comply with all the following:

- I agree to prevent the risk of theft by never leaving my Music Attire in an unsupervised area such as the cafeteria, computer lab, locker room, library, unlocked classroom, restroom, hallways, etc.
- I will report problems with my Music Attire in a timely manner to my music teacher and/or building administration
- I understand that I may not lend the Music Attire to anyone, including family members and friends
- I understand that I have been issued this Music Attire for use at all school concerts, and that I am responsible to come dressed in the attire to all performances
- I understand that if I so choose to get the attire professionally dry cleaned in between concerts I will assume financial responsibility for the cost of doing so
- I assume full responsibility for the cost of repairs and/or replacement if the Music Attire is damaged, lost or stolen. I understand that I am responsible for replacement cost, and that I may
- not meet this obligation by providing Music Attire purchased or obtained elsewhere
