

EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

New Hanover County Schools, under the leadership of the Superintendent, shall continually monitor, evaluate, and analyze the instructional program(s).

Evaluation elements may include but are not limited to the following:

- National, state, and local testing data such as ACT, SAT, EOG/EOC, benchmarks;
- School demographic data such as students, teachers;
- School process data such as programs, professional development, fiscal allocations;
- Perceptual data such as student, teacher, parent, community surveys;
- Regional research studies data such as contracted services; and
- North Carolina Department of Public Instruction data in conjunction with DPI specialists and services.

The Superintendent or designee(s) shall assist principals in carrying out these evaluations to ensure New Hanover County Schools provides an effective learning environment for all students.
