SIP & Budget Review

This year's goals:

1. Decrease students scoring "below proficient" on Reading Inventory reports by 2%.
2. Maintain the number of on track for graduation (95.5%) and increase participation in career-readiness courses by 2%.
3. Increase the number of students who believe they have been personally rewarded for good behavior from 28.7% to 33.7%.
 - a. Done through "High-Five" cards given by faculty and staff.
4. Increase engagement of students with regular differentiated instruction.
