Technology Update

- 1st year of the Three-Year Plan.
 - Trickled technology from the CTE labs into the Media Center for free. District Refresh replaces personal technology for teachers and students. Other old devices will be refreshed with District funding.
 - Laptop carts and chargers were purchased with Trust Land funds.
 - Projectors are being updated throughout the school.
 - School is moving towards being 1-to-1. Right now, there are 1148 devices in the school with about 1300 students enrolled currently.
- Discussed technology use in the future
 - Will students use the devices more if they have more ownership of the devices?
 - Students could rent the devices and use them at school and at home.
 - Students could have a homeroom teacher where the devices goes each afternoon.
