Solicitations By Staff Members

The Board of Education, recognizing its responsibility in the matter of solicitations, shall strive to safeguard from exploitation the students, parents, staff members, school system, and community.

Therefore, no staff member shall use professional relationships with students for private advantage, nor shall any staff member use his/her position to influence parents or students of the school system to purchase instructional supplies, equipment, or books nor sell to any student or parent any instructional supplies, equipment, or books except those expressly approved for classroom or school-related use by the office of the Superintendent.

No staff member shall furnish lists of students' or parents' names, addresses, and telephone numbers or any other information to anyone for solicitations unless prior approval is granted by the Office of the Superintendent.
