



Dear Parents of Current 10th/11th Grade Students,

Stafford High School 10th/11th grade students will take the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT®) on Wednesday, October 16, 2019. Juniors who do well can qualify for national recognition and scholarships based on their performance on the PSAT/NMSQT®. Stafford Municipal School District funds this initiative for 10th/11th grade students in an effort to better prepare them for college level entry exams.

The PSAT/NMSQT measures the reading, writing and language, and math skills students need to be ready for college and career. Calculators will be supplied by the campus for the PSAT/NMSQT so students will only need to bring number 2 pencils and an eraser.

On October 16, 2019, students will report to school and look for testing rosters in the hallways. Students will report directly to their testing rooms where attendance will be taken. It is essential that everyone is on time so that we may begin testing by 8:00am. It is a timed test and the start time cannot be delayed. We encourage students to get a good night's rest and eat a healthy breakfast prior to testing so they are focused and ready.

Students can prepare for the PSAT/NMSQT by doing their best in school. Students may also visit Khan Academy at www.satpractice.org to create a free account to access personalized practice recommendations based on previous years' test results or the results of a series of diagnostic tests. Students may link their Khan Academy account to their [College Board](#) account to receive personalized practice suggestions based on scores of any previous College Board assessment.
