



Dear Parents of Current 12th Grade Students,

We're bringing the SAT® to you this fall!

Stafford High School 12th grade students will have the opportunity to take the SAT at school on October 16, 2019, during the regular school day. The SAT is accepted at all U.S. colleges; it measures what you are already learning and what you need to know to succeed in college and career. Stafford Municipal School District funds this initiative for 11th grade students in an effort to better prepare them for college. This year 12th grade students will have an opportunity to retake the SAT even if they tested during their junior year.

On October 16, 2019, students will report to school and look for testing rosters in the hallways. Students will report directly to their testing rooms where attendance will be taken. It is essential that everyone is on time so that we may begin testing by 8:00am. It is a timed test and the start time cannot be delayed. The total time of the SAT with Essay is 4hrs and 7 mins. We encourage students to get a good night's rest and eat a healthy breakfast prior to testing so they are focused and ready.

Students can prepare for the SAT by doing their best in school. Students may also visit Khan Academy at www.satpractice.org to create a free account to access personalized practice recommendations based on previous years' test results or the results of a series of diagnostic tests. Students may link their Khan Academy account to their [College Board](#) account to receive personalized practice suggestions based on scores of any previous College Board assessment.
