Cost for the project

Post and Deck structure: \$97,210 (\$51,510 with the grant) Poured surfacing (two bids):

- Game Time \$19.81 sq. ft. (5800 sq ft) \$114,000
- Adventure Turf \$10.90 sq. ft. (7800 sq. ft.) \$88,500

Swings - \$8,092

Sensory Whirl - \$10, 500

Shipping - \$2,850 (post and deck structure)

Installation - \$44,270

Summary: \$205,722 for the total project with the grant and using Adventure Turf for the poured surfacing.

Why Banner? What makes us unique?

Banner hosts the District's K - 5 Life Skills program. Currently, there are 22 students from all five elementary buildings:

- Banner 4 students
- Dunlap Grade 3 students
- Hickory Grove 3 students
- Ridgeview 4 students
- Wilder-Waite 8 students

In addition, we have two kindergarten students with mobility challenges.
