

To provide our students with access to the many online resources of the King County Library System, Enumclaw School District partners with KCLS to create special library accounts for all K-12 students in our district. These accounts allow students to log in seamlessly from school, home, or from any computer or device.

The special student accounts:

- **Are easy for students to remember.** The account number is the student's school ID number (lunch number) preceded by the School District number (216).
- **Give each student seamless access.** Students are able to use the array of databases, downloadable materials (through Overdrive) and online homework help services offered by KCLS without needing a physical card.
- **Do not accrue fines or fees.** Since students only have access to electronic materials, it won't be necessary for students to track due dates.

If a student already has a traditional KCLS library card, they can continue to use it to checkout materials from the public library and use in-library computers. The student online account supplements the traditional library card and improves each student's ability to access KCLS online research tools as part of their schoolwork. Teachers throughout the district are able to utilize the many resources available through KCLS to complement their curriculum and build students' experience and expertise utilizing library resources.
