### 1. Understand topics, concepts and processes in social studies.

### 4. Demonstrate effective speaking, writing, and listening.

- Speak to describe, explain, and apply content vocabulary and concepts.
- Write to describe, explain and apply content vocabulary and concepts.
- Listen with purpose to gain information about content vocabulary and concepts.
- Engage in collaborative discussion about content vocabulary and concepts.
