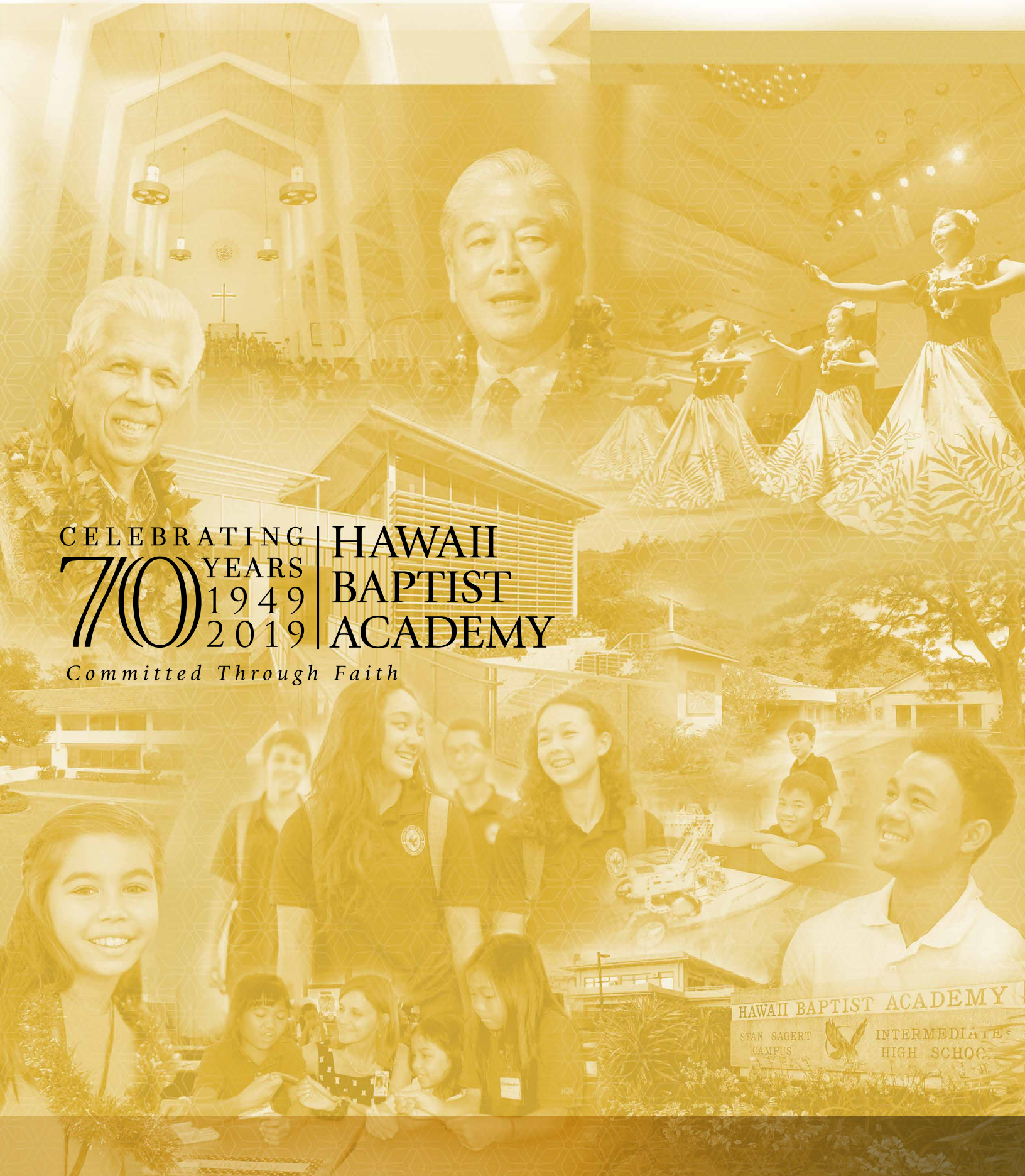

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



Dear Friends,

We are thankful and humbled by God's provision for our school and His love for our students. Thank you for supporting the mission of Hawaii Baptist Academy. As we look back at our 70th anniversary year, we were reminded of God's faithfulness throughout our school's history.

To celebrate our school's milestone anniversary, HBA hosted two important events. The first was our very first community Christmas concert at the Hawaii Convention Center, December 14–15. More than 1,000 guests attended the concert each night, with Saturday's show selling out at nearly 1,600 seats. The performers included all of the school's choirs, the Wind Ensemble, Halau Hula o Kalama Ula, the high school drama class, the Hoomana sign language and praise team, some specially selected elementary students to reenact the Christmas story, and a special performance by New Hope Music and Halau of New Hope alongside of HBA's halau. In addition to featuring HBA's talented students, the event raised funds for the school's financial aid fund. The school also honored The Salvation Army's Hawaiian and Pacific Island Division with a gift of \$8,500.

The second event was our 70th Anniversary Celebration and Legacy Awards at the Hilton Hawaiian Village Waikiki Beach Resort, February 23. At the event, we recognized 10 individuals who have contributed to HBA's success. We also saw many other notable accomplishments this year.

- HBA's Eagle Eye Newspaper received Best-In-State for a fifth consecutive year;
- Reanne Inafuku '19 and Emily White '19 were named National Merit Scholars;
- Adam Hu '19 received the Regents Scholarship from the University of Hawaii at Manoa, and Taylor Eleola '19 received the Chancellor's Scholarship from the University of Hawaii at Hilo;
- seven students participated in the Hawaii State Science and Engineering Fair;
- the middle school hosted its first STEM (science, technology, engineering and math) Day;

- the boys and girls cross country teams won their state championships;
- the girls basketball team won their first state championship since 2016;
- for the first time in our school's history, our boys golf team won their first state championship;
- HBA received the Kaimana Award for overall school excellence for the 12th consecutive year, and 13th time in 14 years;
- Joy Yukumoto's '19 film "We Are U.S." was selected for screening at the Hawaii International Film Festival's Student Showcase;
- Dakota Gavin '19 received a \$3,000 award from a national art competition hosted by the Lowell Milken Center for Unsung Heroes;
- a public service announcement put together by nine middle school students took home top prize in the PSA category at the Youth Xchange Statewide Video Competition, hosted by Olelo Community Media;
- and senior Jada Inouye's self-portrait won third place in the Hawaii District 1 2019 Congressional Art Competition.

Our students also shared the love of Christ with their community in many ways. The middle school raised \$1,000 for Make-A-Wish Hawaii, the second graders raised money to purchase books for homeless children on Oahu's leeward coast, the elementary students raised \$25,000 for the American Heart Association, and our sixth graders saw answered prayers for a woman who was desperately ill.

We remain committed to providing a high quality, college preparatory education rooted in faith. May God continue to lead us into the next phase of our story as we continue to develop global leaders with a Christian worldview who will make an impact in their home, workplace, and community. Thank you for faithfully supporting the ministry of HBA through your prayers and financial support!

Alumni Profile



Robert Carlton **Fulford** '88

THE LORD led me to Hawaii Baptist Academy in the summer of 1985, as I was entering my sophomore year. Immediately upon meeting with Mrs. Kathy Lee '69, the admissions director, I felt the Lord lay on my heart that this was where he wanted me to go to school. I feel deeply blessed to have spent the majority of my high school years studying and fellowshiping at this amazing school.

My fondest memories of HBA are the people—teachers, coaches, classmates, teammates, administration, and families—all of whom were profoundly impactful on me and my family, remaining so to this day. My wife and I had Isaiah 40:31, the school's alma mater, engraved inside of our wedding rings. It is also the life verse for our daughter, Mary Elizabeth. Coincidentally, we share a home church here in Alexandria, Virginia, with fellow HBA alumnus Jason Mori '59.

But they that wait upon the Lord, shall renew their strength; they shall mount up on wings like eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint. ISAIAH 40:31

My most influential teachers were Mrs. Joyce Wong, Ms. Maurine King, Mr. John Hom, Mrs. Diane Hom, Ms. Pat Ota and Mr. Curtis Tsuruda. HBA alumnus Lance Kakimoto '80 was my Sunday School teacher at Nuuanu Baptist Church. Also, the entire Young (Andy and Mary Ann) family embraced our family, showing us the love of the Lord and the Aloha spirit. These men and women demonstrated a personal interest in my spiritual and academic growth. Their collective mentorship and discipleship helped prepare me for life beyond HBA, at the Naval Academy, and now after 27 years of service in the Marine Corps.

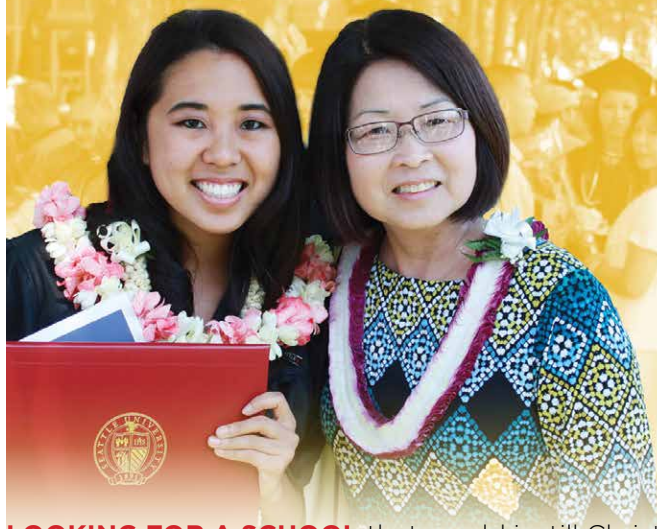
Perhaps the most meaningful lesson I carried away from HBA is the saving power of God's amazing grace through His Son, Jesus Christ. It is inspiring to see how the faculty and staff of HBA unconditionally shower grace and love upon the students and their families. I earnestly pray that the Lord will use me and my family as instruments of His grace where he calls us to serve Him.

HBA is dear to our family's hearts. Both my parents and I are humbled to be donors to HBA. We know firsthand the value of the spiritual, academic, and physical development that occurs here. We pray that our small gifts will further the Lord's work through His school.

As we move forward in the Marine Corps, my family and I are grateful to the men and women that the Lord blessed us to serve alongside over the years. We are honored by the opportunity to continue serving the Marines, Sailors, and their families.

Robert C. Fulford is a brigadier general in the U.S. Marine Corps assigned to duties in Washington, DC. In his senior year at HBA he was named Scholar Athlete of the year. Subsequently, the Fulfords established the Rob Fulford Scholar-Athlete Scholarship Endowment, which provides a scholarship award to a male and female scholar athlete each year. His parents, Carlton and Mary Ann Fulford, reside in Maryland and are members of the Mainland Advisory Council. Mary Ann taught social studies at HBA in the late 1980s and Carlton is a retired Marine Corps general.

Why I Give: **PAYING IT FORWARD**

LOOKING FOR A SCHOOL that would instill Christian values and provide a well-rounded education for their daughter, the Lee family found HBA.

“From our first Kindergarten interview with Mr. Tim Kaneshiro '70, we knew HBA was the right fit for Stacie. HBA met all of our expectations and we valued the love and support we received from the faculty and staff throughout her 13 years there,” shares Stacie’s mother, Julie Lee.



“Looking back, high school really was a great time in my life. I think it’s because I took advantage of the opportunities that HBA had to offer, such as working part time at the elementary school as an after school care leader, being a part of our class council, and participating in the Cross Country and Track and Field teams,” reminisces Stacie.

“My senior year was probably the most memorable. For example our 4x400 track team finished third in the state championship meet, our class council planned events such as a huge slip-n-slide at Kakaako, and the neighbor island trips for running meets were always a blast. I have to say, the main reason why I enjoyed it so much was the friendships I’ve made at HBA.”

Over the years, there have been many teachers and staff that have influenced Stacie’s life, like fourth grade teacher Mrs. Karen Iseri who would always check up on her throughout high school and give her honest advice. Stacie looked up to her as someone who was genuine and rooted in Christ. To this day, Stacie and her mother continue their friendship with Mrs. Iseri.

During her senior year at Hawaii Baptist Academy, Stacie was awarded the O.W. “Dub” Efurd Memorial Scholarship at the school’s annual scholarship awards ceremony. Little did she know then that this gift was a blessing that would lead to a cycle of reciprocity nine years later.

“We were surprised and honored when Stacie was awarded the Efurd scholarship in 2010. College is a huge investment and having this scholarship gave us peace of mind financially. The Efurd’s also gifted a book with a handwritten letter, which gave the award such a thoughtful and personal touch. The scholarship was a small fraction of what a four year university costs, but it was such a blessing to be awarded it,” said Julie Lee.

Filled with gratitude, Stacie and Julie decided they would one day pay it forward and bless another family. The scholarship not only helped the Lee family financially, but it displayed the power of God’s love through the Efurd’s example.

After graduating from HBA, Stacie attended Seattle University and received her degree in nursing. She has been working as a registered nurse at Harborview Medical Center Level I trauma center in Seattle. This past year Stacie has also been serving as a travel nurse in Los Angeles, California.

Through prayerful consideration, Stacie and her mother decided it was the right time to give back by establishing a family scholarship to help a graduating senior.

In April 2019, **Chansen Oshiro** '19 was named the first recipient of the Stacie and Julie Lee Scholarship to help



defray the cost of college tuition. Chansen is currently a Freshman at the University of Las Vegas Nevada studying engineering.

“The advice I wish to share with current students is to take advantage of opportunities that are offered to you, especially the ones that are outside of your comfort zone. It’s so easy to push back ideas and say, ‘One day I’ll get to it’ or ‘I’ll get to it later’. The Bible tells us to love others, and it takes a lot of work sometimes, but we are called to put action behind those thoughts and ideas and do it now, not later.”

MAC Spotlight



FOR BILL AND CAROLYN COBB, growing up in the country during the 1950's was a simpler time. Back then, you worked long hours in the fields bailing hay, or picking cotton, with food as your payment. Clothing and shoes were hand-me-downs from older siblings. Social gatherings revolved around church, and from an early age, children were taught to give a portion of their earnings to the Lord.

"I remember my dad would give me a nickel, and as I got older a dime, to give to the offering plate until I was able to give on my own," recalls Mr. Cobb. "The Bible teaches us that it is more blessed to give than to receive (Acts 20:35), and for Carolyn and I, it gives us great joy to see the excitement in the children's eyes at HBA. That's why we give. We don't have children so this is our way of helping others in need, and we are at a phase in our lives where we can do so."

About eight years ago, the Cobbs joined the Mainland Advisory Council (MAC) through the gentle nudging of Dr. Darold Morgan, Ed Spurling and Bob Spottswood, whom they had great respect for as leaders in their church, First Baptist Richardson in Texas. Since joining, Mr. Cobb has served as MAC Chair and Vice-Chair.

"MAC Week is a highlight for us year after year. After interacting with the kids, you can't help but leave with a warm heart. Every year we fall in love with the students, and you see how supportive and thankful the faculty, staff and parents are."

"Through hard work over the years, we have been blessed with the financial resources and have made a prayerful decision to give back to HBA because of all the wonderful things we witness with the students, and the overall school environment. We choose to give because we know that HBA provides a quality Christian education that weaves the spiritual and academic side in perfect balance," shares Mr. Cobb. "Our hope is that others will appreciate the value that HBA has in the lives of the youth and that alumni will also want to give back to their school."

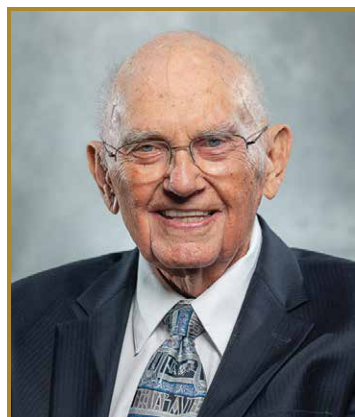

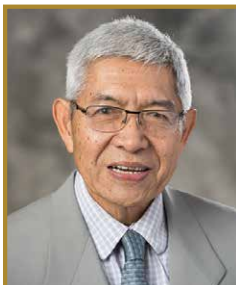

- Private Movie Screenings

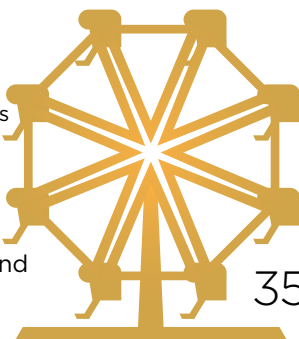

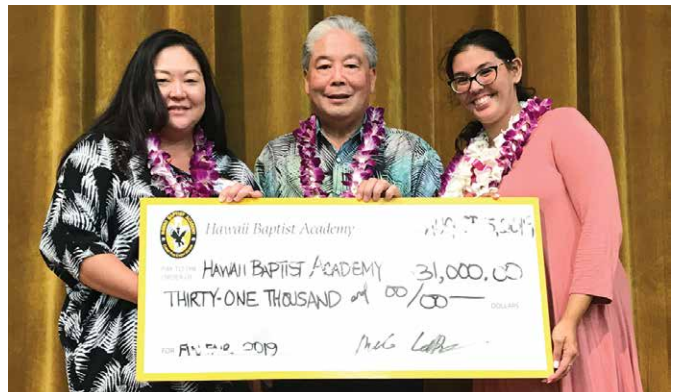

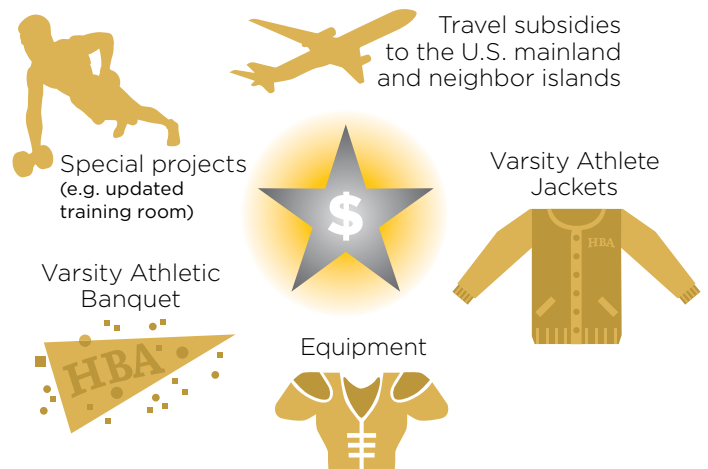


Through their tremendous fundraising efforts, the Athletic Booster Club has supported the school in many ways.
