本周，Tim Gerrish先生在校内对NIS的儿童保护程序进行了全面的审核。他是国际儿童保护顾问（ICPA）的熟悉顾问，并且与我们主要的认证机构，国际学校理事会（CIS）合作密切。蒂姆（Tim）是伦敦新苏格兰场的一名退休警探，他曾在一个专门针对儿童犯罪的部门工作。

本周，他走校园里花了四天的时间，与学生、家长、校务委员会、学校各个领域的工作人员交谈，包括清洁工、园丁和保安，教师和领导团队。整个过程由我们的儿童保护主任 Ruth Clarke女士领导。我们已经对所有政策和程序进行了全面的审核，并将在接下来的几周之内完成一份全面的报告。

我最大的职责正是保证我们所有的学生，您的孩子们，在校内的安全。在NIS随身佩戴ID卡正是我们作为社区的一员的所有行动的开端。我们还应当拥有一个强劲的系统来支持任何一位想要揭露情况的学生或成年人。尽管在NIS我们从未发生过重大的儿童保护案件，但我们仍应该采取积极主动的预防和行动，以确保这一点能够继续坚持下去。

NIS에서의 아동 보호

이번 주는 팀 게리스 Tim Gerrish 씨가 저희 학교에서 NIS 아동 보호 절차의 전체적인 감사를 진행하고 있습니다. 팀은 저희 학교의 주요 인증 기관인 국제학교 협의회(CIS-Council of International Schools)와 긴밀하게 협력하는 국제 아동 보호 자문(ICPA-International Child Protection Advisors) 기구의 선임 컨설턴트입니다. 팀은 런던 경시청 형사로 근무하였으며 아동을 대상으로 하는 범죄를 전문으로 수사 하는 부서에서 근무했습니다.

팀은 이번 주 4일 동안 학교에서 학생, 부모, 이사회, 청소 담당, 정원 담당 및 보안담당을 포함한 전 영역의 직원, 교사 및 리더십 팀과 대화를 나누었습니다. 전체 절차는 본교의 아동 보호 담당자인 Mrs. Ruth Clarke의 주도로 진행되었습니다. 학교의 정책과 절차에 대한 포괄적인 감사가 이루어졌으며 이는 차후 수주간에 걸쳐 완전하고도 포괄적인 감사 보고서로 작성됩니다.

여러분의 자녀인 동시에 저희의 학생인 아이들이 학교에서 안전하도록 보호하는 일은 저의 가장 큰 의무입니다. ID 카드 착용은 NIS에서 저희가 커뮤니티로서 취해야 하는 모든 행동의 출발점입니다. 저희는 또한 폭로하고자 하는 학생 또는 성인을 지원할 수 있는 강력한 시스템을 갖춰야 합니다. NIS에서 아동 보호 관련 중대한 사안이 발생한 적은 없지만 계속해서 확실하게 이 상태를 유지하려면 저희는 상황에 앞서 예방에 최선을 다해야 합니다.

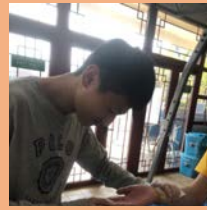

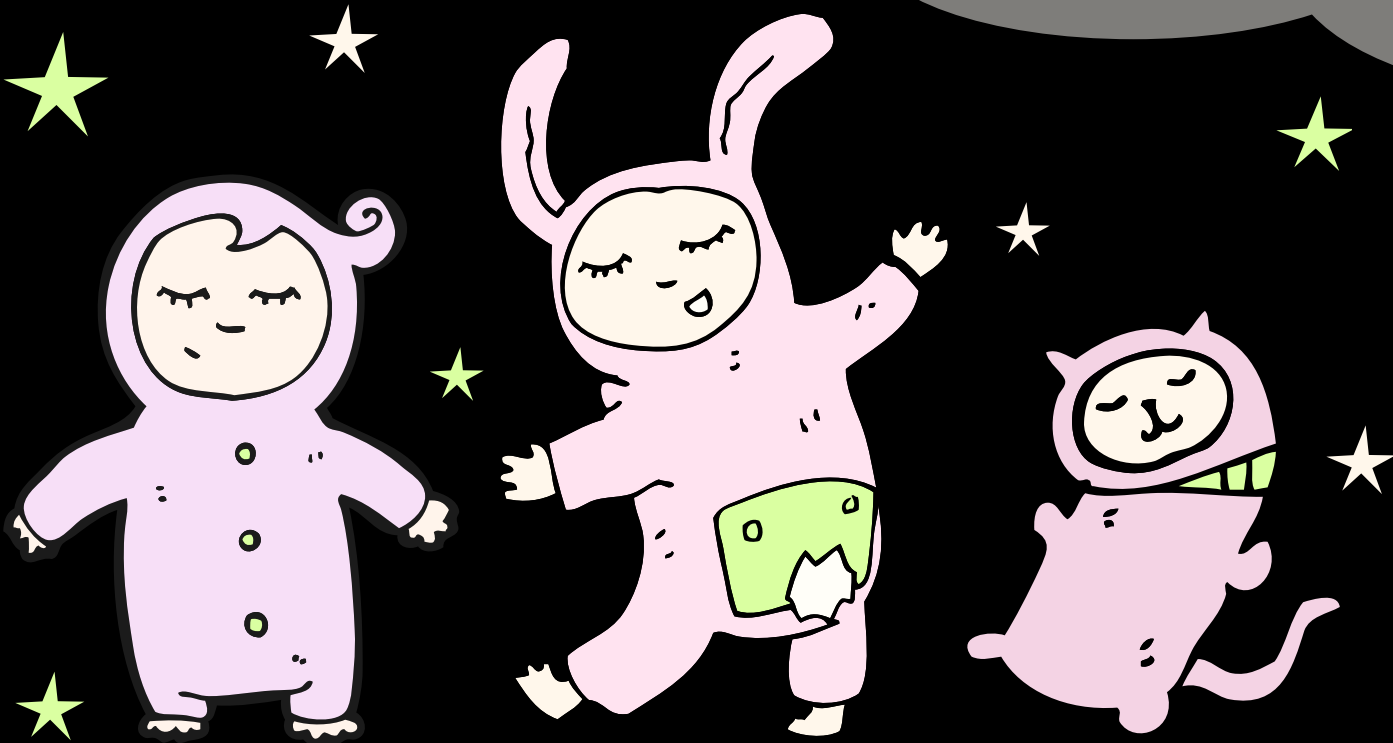

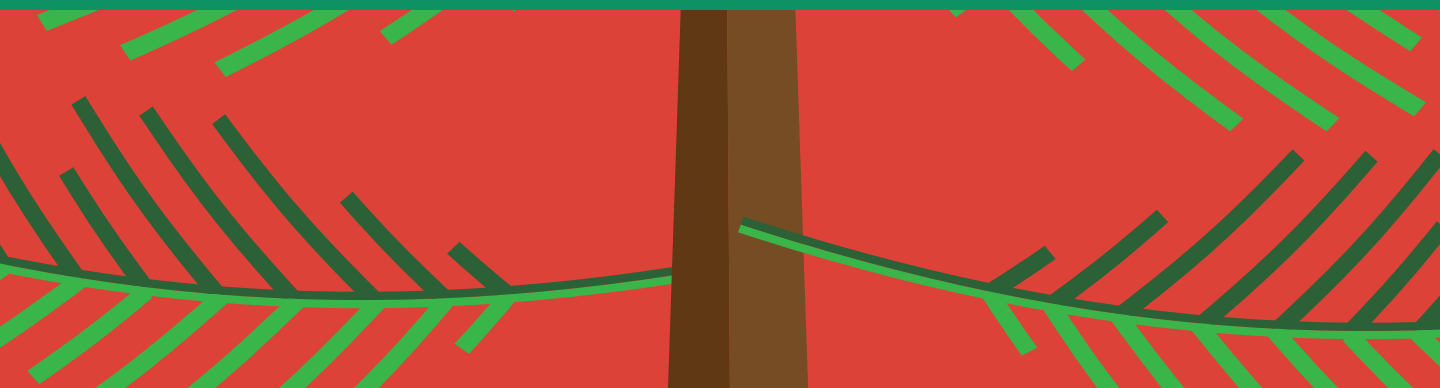

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR LEAVING FAMILIES

Dear Parents,

This is a time of year when some of our families will be moving on from Nanjing, either returning to their home countries or embarking on their next overseas posting. To assist our planning for the coming semester please read and follow the exit procedure below. This information may have a direct impact on new families wishing to enter our school. Your help with providing this information as early as possible is much appreciated.

Exit Procedure

1. Once you know you are leaving please send an email to admissions@nanjing-school.com indicating your intention to leave and requesting any documentation that you may require. Let us have the name of your child or children, their current grades as well as your expected leaving date.
2. Collect a clearance form from Reception, or download off the website.
3. Clearance forms need to be completed for each leaving student.
4. On the last day of school documents will only be handed over if we have received your completed clearance form.

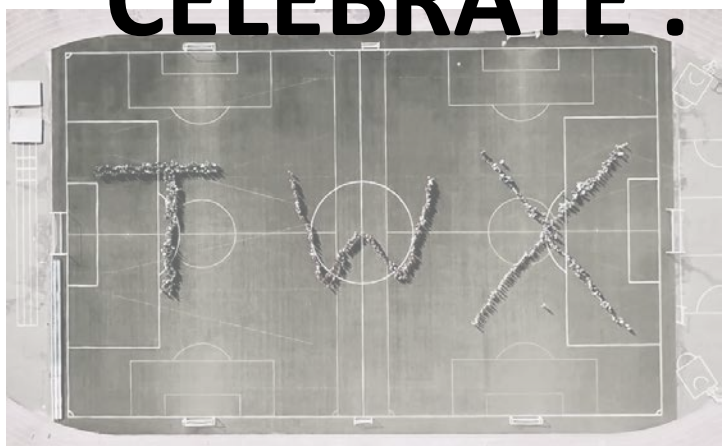

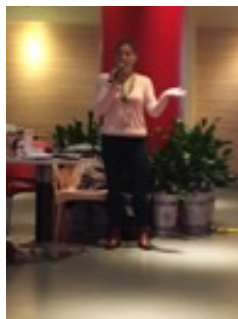


•PTA Birthday Cupcakes!
