It is the responsibility of the Milford Board of Education (Board) to maintain and improve the quality of administration and instruction in the public school system. In this regard, the evaluation of administrators will take place under the direction of the Superintendent in accordance with State Statutes and the district teacher evaluation plan and the administrators' contract.

Evaluation of the Superintendent will be done annually by the Board, in accordance with the Superintendent's contract, State Statutes and the Board's Policy Governance process.
