#### Fiscal Strength

- Fiscally Sound with Solid Revenue Growth
  - Reserves total \$34.4 million
  - Per pupil spending for 2018-19 was \$21,462
  - The total revenue is projected to increase by \$1.6 million this year over last
  - Property tax revenue for 2019-20 is estimated at \$57.7
     million
  - The total budget for this year is roughly \$64 million


#### **Chronic Absenteeism Rate (10% or more absences)**



California Assessment of Student Progress and Performance (CAASPP) - Percent of Students Meeting or Exceeding Standards




California Assessment of Student Progress and Performance (CAASPP) - Percent of Student Groups Meeting or Exceeding Standards


