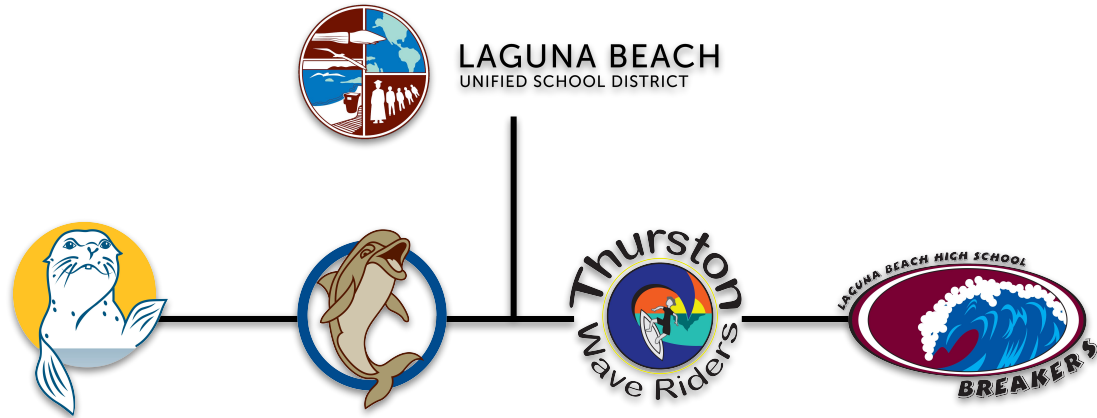
Outcomes

Safety Committee

- Increased participation
- Added LBPD participants
- Added LBFD participants
- Safety consultant assistance
- Established subcommittee
- Significant updates to comprehensive district safety plan
- Added reunification section
- Updated site maps and evacuation routes



The Safety Committee is a team of staff, parents, and students that meet quarterly to discuss ways to improve our approach to safety. Representation is comprised from all the sites.

Facility Upgrades

- Added generators
- District-wide rekey and hardware upgrades
- Added roof labels (LBPD rec.)
- Added dedicated analog phones
- Standardized emergency supplies
- Added fencing
- Enhancing security cameras
- Adding window coverings
- Adding panic buttons
- Improved signage and building identification

Drills & Tabletop Exercises

- Annual tabletop exercise with LBPD
- Conducting tabletop at each school in 2019-20
 - Refine school-specific plans
 - Finalizing reunification
- Adding reunification supply bins for implementation
- Conduct all State-mandated drills
- Observed active shooter simulation and police training at LCAD
- Participated in Active Shooter drills
