

Davis High School Community Council Minutes
October 9, 2019
6:30 a.m.

Council Chair Kate Niederhauser welcomed the Community Council. The Council reviewed the minutes from the September 11, 2019. Shanna Barker motioned they be approved. Gregg Laub seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.

Dr. Wilkey reviewed the Trust Lands budget. He identified expenditures already incurred. Pending expenditures for certain areas of the improvement plan were discussed including ACT test prep and Technology Improvement.

Kate Niederhauser reminded the Council of upcoming Community Council training, and recommended attendance.

The student representatives reported that that Homecoming was a success with a lot of participation. Street painting was identified as a particular success with large turnout. Fall sports are winding down. The Spirit Bowl continues. The class competition remains close.

The Council reviewed ACT, AP, and CE data from the from 2018-2019 school year. DHS ACT scores are all above state averages, composite score increased from previous year, and number of students meeting state benchmarks increased. AP participation remains consistent with a slight decrease from last year, but DHS continues to enjoy a very high passage rate. DHS students earned 20% of the District's CE credits.

Office Bradshaw discussed current issues/struggles students face. There was a constructive discussion on mental health/illness concerns and frustrations DHS faces in helping students with mental health issues. Concerns with vaping were also discussed, along with a connection between mental health issues and use of vapes and other drugs.

Shanna Barker agreed to serve as the Kaysville Schools Communications representative for the Council.

Kate Niederhauser motioned that the meeting be adjourned. Lance Thaxton seconded the motion, and the meeting was adjourned. The next meeting will be on November 6, 2019 at 6:30 am.
