Introduction to Dungeons & Dragons: Lower Elementary, Grades 1-3 (4:00 - 5:00 PM)

\$200 for 8 Classes - Dates: 1/13, 1/27, 2/3, 2/10, 2/24, 3/2, 3/9, 3/16 (no class on 1/20, 2/17)

Learn the basics of the world's greatest roleplaying game! Students will explore subterranean labyrinths, plunder hoards of treasure, and fight legendary monsters, all while practicing critical skills for reading comprehension, critical thinking, and cooperative problem-solving. Led by Upper Elementary's Alden Kendall, this is a class that won't soon be forgotten!

Scratch: Upper Elementary, Grades 3-6 (4:10 - 5:10 PM)

Scratch is a popular programming language designed especially for kids, that utilizes Java and was developed at MIT. Kids who take our Scratch class will learn its foundations while using fundamental coding concepts to create animations and computer games. Kodu: Lower Elementary, Grades 1-3 (4:10 - 5:10 PM)

\$305 for 8 Classes - Dates: 1/14, 1/21, 1/28, 2/4, 2/11, 2/18, 2/25, 3/3

Kodu is a visual programming language that allows kids to bring their imaginations to life and helps them develop critical skills like storytelling, creativity, and problem-solving. Students will learn to make their own 3D video games by using fundamental coding concepts such as loops, variable, and constructors. Kodu is a great introduction to coding and a lot of fun! Floor Hockey: Elementary, Grades 1-6 (4:10 - 5:10 PM)

\$215 for 8 Classes - Dates: 1/14, 1/21, 1/28, 2/4, 2/11, 2/18, 2/25, 3/3

Led by Mr. Katinas himself, this class will focus on the basics of hockey. Stick handling, passing, and shooting will be practiced and developed. With a strong emphasis on spacing and team play, this class will teach physical and strategic skills and habits that can translate to other team sports in addition to hockey. Sewing Club: Elementary, Grades 1-6 (4:10 - 5:10 PM)

\$250 for 8 Classes - Dates: 1/15, 1/22, 1/29, 2/5, 2/12, 2/19, 2/26, 3/4

Students will learn the lost art of sewing by hand through a variety of fun projects. Focusing primarily on the running and blanket stitch, students will sew animals, key-chains, "too-hot holders", clothing, and seasonal projects. Students will receive their own sewing kit, and learn about the different materials needed to properly sew. This class is designed for beginner sewers but all sewing enthusiasts are welcome!

Tennis: Elementary, Grades 1-6 (4:10 - 5:10 PM)

Book Arts: Elementary, Grades 1-6 (4:10 - 5:10 PM)

\$200 for 8 Classes - Dates: 1/16, 1/23, 1/30, 2/6, 2/13, 2/20, 2/27, 3/5

In this class, we'll expand our paper engineering skills and learn how paper and books are made. We'll craft our own recycled paper and explore printmaking and marbling. Then we'll combine what we've learned to make our own books!

Advanced Dungeons & Dragons: Upper Elementary, Grades 3-6 (4:00 - 5:00 PM)

\$200 for 8 Classes - Dates: 1/16, 1/23, 1/30, 2/6, 2/13, 2/20, 2/27, 3/5

Dive back into the world of Dungeons and Dragons! Players in this class will learn how to create their own characters before setting off on a completely new adventure, all while developing teamwork, reading comprehension, and critical thinking skills. Open to Upper Elementary students only; DnD experience useful, but not required.

Breakdancing: Elementary, Grades 1-6 (4:10 - 5:10 PM)

\$230 for 8 Classes - Dates: 1/16, 1/23, 1/30, 2/6, 2/13, 2/20, 2/27, 3/5

The Lab's Break Dance program is designed to introduce students to dance using basic Breakin' techniques and skills. Instructors will teach basic Breakin' to develop strength, coordination and gross motor skills (skipping, hopping, leaping, etc). They will encourage physical activity, teamwork and confidence through rhythm based activities in a fun and exciting class setting. The program will help your young dancer develop better balance, coordination, listening skills and other social skills.

Kids Fit: Elementary, Grades 1-6 (4:00 - 5:00 PM)

This class is led by Mr. Luke Kovacs, who is the physical education teacher at Janney Elementary School and also teaches Boys Will Run at Aidan in the fall and spring. Students will work on a variety of cardiovascular and strength-training using different exercise implements. In general, the days will be set up with the exercises in an alternating circuit. Depending on the day, exercises will be team driven or individual tasks. The class may venture outside depending on weather.
