The Parents/ Carers will:

- Ensure children arrive to school on time, dressed in the required uniform.
- Ensure their child has all the equipment necessary for their school day i.e. homework, PE kit
- Provide explanation of absences on each day a child is not in school.
- Make the academy aware of any concerns that may affect the child's behaviour or performance in school.
- Support the Behaviour for Learning policy (found on website)
- Read daily with their child as out lined in their reading record.
- Be aware of homework and completion dates (found on website)
- Attend parent consultations.
- Be involved in their child's school life whenever possible.
- Not arrange holidays during term time.

The pupils will:

- Attend school regularly and arrive on time.
- Do all class work and homework to the best of their ability.
- Always behave kindly and sensibly in class, assembly, corridors and on the playground.
- Be polite, helpful and considerate to everyone within the school and outside.
- Wear school uniform and be tidy in appearance, remembering that they represent their school.
- Look after their belongings.
- Tell their teacher if they are concerned about something, so that it can be dealt with swiftly.
- Adhere to academy rules at all times.
