Thank you for your interest in being a delegate to the Round Square International Conference. Five students will have the opportunity to represent Marvelwood at the 2020 Conference at Scotch Oakburn College in Australia in September. (exact dates to be announced). Applicants should be age 16-19 in 2020-2021 (even if you're turning 16 after the conference dates). The total cost for the trip is ~\$3,500 and will include a pre- or post-conference trip. Some scholarship is available.

First and foremost, while you are abroad you are acting as an ambassador of the United States and more specifically as an ambassador of The Marvelwood School. This is a position that is not to be taken lightly, as your time with the host school will leave a deep and lasting impression that will impact future trips. - While visiting Australia, you must abide by their laws.
- You will write an article for the school's magazine, the Blue & White, upon your return.
- You will present at a school meeting with the other delegates about the experience.
- Marvelwood's student code of conduct remains in effect while you are abroad, and violation of major school rules while on the trip will result in severe consequences.
