Sport Premium Funding Outcomes 2015/2016

The school is provided with PE and Sport Premium funding by the DfE/EFA. The funding is provided to develop or add to the PE and sport activities that the school already offers and make improvements now, that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years.

The funding is calculated as £8,000 for any school with 17 or more pupils with an additional £5 per pupil in year 1 and above.

In the 2015/16 academic year the school received funding to the value of £8,600.

During the 2015/16 academic year, the school worked with Premier Sport who provided specialised sport coaches to work alongside our teachers. This provided wider sporting opportunities, including the preparation and running of our tournament to celebrate the opening of our new Multi Use Games Area (MUGA). Lunchtime clubs are provided by the coaches to promote physical activity. This has supported our MDSAs in continuing this provision on days of the week when the coaches are not in school.

The tournament was the third one held by the school since the introduction of the PE and sport premium funding, which has allowed our older children to participate in competitive games. The trophy provided by Baxall construction for year on year use, will be award to a child who has made outstanding progress with their PE skills.

After school sporting activities for children in year 1 and 2 have run twice a week which at a reduced charge to parents. The activities provided were, Basketball, Dodgeball and Cricket.

The MUGA is now in use throughout the school day. In recognition of the money spent by the school on developing the MUGA the PTA has organised fundraising activities to enrich the PE equipment available for use during PE lessons, lunch and afterschool clubs. This area is now available for the local community to access out of school hours.
