## Sport Premium Funding Outcomes 2014/2015

The school is provided with PE and Sport Premium funding by the DfE/EFA. The funding is provided to develop or add to the PE and sport activities that the school already offers and make improvements now, that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years.

The funding is calculated as £8,000 for any school with 17 or more pupils with an additional £5 per pupil in year 1 and above.

In the 2014/15 academic year the school received funding to the value of £8,590.

During the 2014/15 academic year, the school worked with Albion in the Community who provided specialised sport coaches to work alongside our teachers. This provided wider sporting opportunities, including the preparation and running of our tennis skills tournament with our neighbouring school.

The tournament was the second one held by the school since the introduction of the PE and sport premium funding, which has allowed our older children to participate in competitive games. The trophy provided by Baxall construction last year for year on year use, was won by Sacred Heart school. All children received a medal for taking part, which was funded by our sport premium funding.

After school sporting activities for children in year 1 and 2 were run twice a week which were free of charge to parents. The activities provided were, tennis skills, football and multi skills.

The school is also working with external parties towards building a new multi games area within the school grounds. This will benefit all children attending the school from 2015 onwards as well as some community use. Some of the funding has been used to enable the process of moving this project forward with the planning authority for completion in November 2015.
