Procedures for deliveries and communication with students during the school day:

In order to communicate and make necessary deliveries to your student in the building during a school day, we need your assistance. Our goal is to provide communication to and with your student with minimal interruption to the academic process.

- No fast food and take out lunch deliveries are allowed, i.e. pizza, Panera, etc. Please contact an administrator if your student has specific dietary needs.
-
- If a student is providing food for a classroom party/event, the items must be dropped off in the teacher's classroom before school begins in the morning.
- Absences and/or early dismissal phone calls should be made first thing in the morning so there is adequate time to inform the student to come pick up their early dismissal pass. The Attendance Office will send a Schoology message to your student to make them aware of their pass. If last minute arrangements are needed due to an emergency, please call the student's Assistant Principal.
- Please remind your students that they need to exit the building by 2:25 pm unless they have official school business such as a club, sport, theatre, tutoring, etc.
- All previous graduates of Athens should make arrangements to visit their former teachers before and after regular school hours. Visiting during lunch at the Terrace Café is always a great option. Visits during school will be restricted to alumni that have secured arrangements in writing by the host teacher.

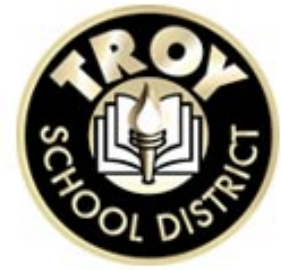

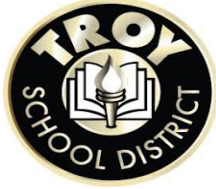

Pay to Participate Program for Athletics/Clubs/Intramural Activities

Troy School District will continue the "Pay to Participate" program for athletics, clubs and intramural activities for the 2019-20 school year. The district will assess a fee to those students participating in interscholastic athletics (Grade 7-12). In addition, a separate fee will be assessed to students (Grade 6-12) who participate in intramural and/or club activities.

The parameters of this program include the following:

IMPORTANT PAYMENT NOTICE:

- Payment for participation in high school and middle school sports is due following team try-outs (approximately one (1) to two (2) weeks after the start of practice). The coach will announce the date the fee is due. The attached Pay to Participate form should be turned in to the coach or an authorized Athletic Department representative for your student's sport. The fee must be processed through Payschools, available through the TSD website link www.troy.k12.mi.us
- A \$175.00 per sport fee (1st and 2nd sport) will be assessed per high school athlete for the 2019-20 school year.* The payment is made through the "athletics link" on Payschools only. If you are unable to make a payment through Payschools, please contact the TSD Athletic Office at 248.823.5154 to make arrangements to drop off your payment.
- A \$75.00 per sport fee (1st and 2nd sport) will be assessed per middle school athlete for the 2019-20 school year.*The payment is made through the "athletics link" on Payschools only. If you are unable to make a payment through Payschools, please contact the TSD Athletic Office at 248.823.5154 to make arrangements to drop off your payment.

****A maximum \$600.00 fee per household/per year for athletic participation, applies to those families who have multiple students participating in your home.***

- A \$50.00 fee will be assessed for high school and middle school students participating in clubs or intramurals for the 2019-20 school year. *This payment is made through the "individual link on your school's website" for Payschools. If you are unable to make a payment through Payschools, please contact your home school office to make arrangements to drop off a payment.

****A maximum \$100.00 fee per household/per year for clubs and/or intramurals applies to those families who have multiple students participating in your home.***

- Participation Fees will be assessed one time annually.
- A student MAY NOT participate in a scrimmage or contest, intramural or club related activity, until the completed contract has been received by the club sponsor, coach or Athletic Director and all participation fees have been paid. These fees are payable through Payschools. **NO CHECKS SHOULD BE GIVEN TO COACHES.**
- A reduction in the "Pay to Participate" athletic fees will be available to students with financial hardships. Participants in the Troy School District Free and/or Reduced Lunch Program will qualify for this reduction. All Information is kept confidential.

If you have been approved for the Free Lunch Program, you will receive credit for the athletic team(s) you participate in for the 2019-20 school year. If you are approved for the Reduced Lunch Program, you must pay 25% of the "Pay to Participate" fee.

Please "check" the "Request for Waiver" box on the Athletic Participation Fee, Transportation Agreement and Letter of Understanding form. The form should be accompanied by a completed Free and/or Reduced Lunch Program form and a Sharing Information with Other Programs form to apply for the reduction in the "Pay to Participate" fee. - There are NO REFUNDS of a "Pay to Participate" fee which has been paid unless the student athlete suffers a season ending injury prior to mid-point of the season which precludes them from participating in one-half of the regularly scheduled contests. A medical authorization letter from a physician must accompany any such request. Requests for refunds should be made to the Athletic Department at (248) 823-5154 before the mid-point of the season.

Seniors

At this time seniors have been searching and/or should be searching for scholarships. Some students will be awarded scholarships from colleges and universities upon admission. To assist students in their search, there is information about numerous scholarships on the Athens website.

Juniors

All juniors will take the SAT in April at Athens High School. There is no fee or sign up for this test date. The SAT, like the ACT, is a college entrance exam accepted by colleges to help determine whether a student is a good fit academically for a specific college or university. Either test, the ACT or SAT, is accepted by college admission offices to be considered as part of an admission decision for a student. We encourage college bound juniors to take the SAT more than once and/or take the ACT one or more times. Both the ACT and SAT are offered on multiple dates in area locations throughout the year. Junior year is a good time to research and visit colleges in order to determine which colleges are a good fit. We encourage college bound students to apply to 3 to 5 schools at the beginning of senior year.

SAT Reporting/Save \$\$\$

When students complete the ACT or SAT registration form, they are offered the opportunity to have their score sent to up to four colleges at no charge. We strongly recommend that students take advantage of this opportunity. Ordering scores at registration helps to streamline the college application process as well as save students the costs associated with sending scores at a later time. Please report all tests.

Students benefit from identifying four schools to which they may apply when registering. This is not a commitment to apply to any school listed. The schools hold the students' scores in the event they apply.

What You Need to Know About Registering for SELECTIVE SERVICE

[Q] What is Selective Service?

[A] The Selective Service is a government agency whose job is to provide untrained manpower for the Armed Forces if there's a national emergency.

[Q] What is Selective Service Registration?

[A] By registering, you add your name to a list of all the men in the nation, ages 18 through 25. The list would be used to identify men for possible military service in case of a national emergency.

[Q] What happens if there's a draft?

[A] There hasn't been a draft since 1973. If there were an emergency sufficient for congress to order another draft, Selective Service would conduct a birth date lottery to decide the order in which to call men. Those who turn 20 during that calendar year would be called first in a sequence determined by the lottery. If more men were needed, those 21 to 25 would be called, youngest first.

[Q] Who is required to register?

[A] The law says that all 18-year-old men (including U.S. citizens living abroad and non-citizen immigrant males 18-25 residing in the U.S.) must register. The only young men exempt from registration are non-citizen males who are in the U.S. temporarily as tourists, diplomats and their family members or foreign exchange students; incarcerated or institutionalized men; men on active duty in the Armed Forces; and students at U.S. military academies.

[Q] Why don't women have to register?

[A] Our nation only registers men. This has always been the case. Selective Service law as it is presently written refers specifically to "male persons" in stating who must register and who could be subject to a draft. Therefore, Selective Service procedures do not apply to women. In order for women to be required to register with Selective Service, Congress would have to change the wording of the law.

[Q] What if I don't register?

[A] You are breaking the law. If prosecuted, you could be sent to prison for up to 5 years and may be fined up to \$250,000. In addition, if you fail to register, you cannot qualify for federal student grants or loans for college, job training benefits and many state and federal jobs.

[Q] Is registration hard?

[A] No. In fact it's never been easier. A young man can register with Selective Service in less than 2 minutes via the Internet at: www.sss.gov. You can also register by going to your local post office and completing a registration form. It's as simple as filling in your name, address, telephone number, date of birth and Social Security number. Registration forms should be available in your local recreation or social service center, school's guidance or registrar office, or you may receive a form in the mail. Simply complete it and mail the form to Selective Service.

[Q] When should I register?

[A] Within 20 days of your 18th birthday. If you cannot register on time because you are hospitalized or in prison, you have 30 days in which to register after you are released. If 30 days have already passed since your 18th birthday, register immediately, either online or at your post office. Although Selective Service will accept a late registration, the longer you wait, the longer you are breaking the law and jeopardizing your future benefits.

[Q] How do I prove I registered?

[A] When registering via the Internet, you will receive your Selective Service number immediately. That number is your proof of registration - for safe keeping, jot it down. You will receive a Selective Service card by mail within 2 weeks confirming that number. (Note: If you registered by mail, you will receive a card confirming your registration within 60-90 days.) If you don't get your card within 90 days, write to:
