Schools are required to invite transition-age students to participate in an Individualized Education Program (IEP) team meeting when transition planning or postsecondary goals will be discussed. Is your son or daughter ready?

This workshop is for students with IEPs in 8<sup>th</sup> grade or above and their parents. Participants will learn how to use the IEP to support the transition to adulthood. Participants will also learn how each required part of the IEP can be developed to meet the student's transition needs.

- Parents should bring a copy of their child's current IEP and are welcome regardless of their child's attendance
- Students will participate in a separate workshop where they will create a self-advocacy tool
