Eligibility

Applicants must:

1. Be a current freshman, sophomore, or junior student in good standing at Resurrection College Prep High School and enrolled for the following school year.
2. Demonstrate financial need.*
3. Be involved in a leadership role in the school, parish, and/or community.

- ✓ The Blessed Celine and Mother Hedwig Scholarship is a one-time award.
- ✓ Three scholarships are awarded each year; one each in the values of \$1,500, \$1,000, and \$500.
- ✓ Applicants may re-apply on a yearly basis.
- ✓ Scholarship will be forfeited if recipient does not complete the academic year for which it is awarded.
