



The Dr. Chris Kelly Student Mentor Scholarship

Dr. Chris Kelly, alumna from the class of 1959 - Wife, Mother, Teacher, and Mentor. While raising three children, Dr. Kelly taught Mathematics at Resurrection College Prep High School spanning a 30-year period. In addition to this, she was a member of the Resurrection College Prep High School Board, Resurrection Hospital Board of Directors, and an advisor to several Catholic elementary school boards. Her commitment to mentoring led her to create the Practicum Program at Resurrection. From 1998 to 2008, she served as a Professor of Education at Dominican University, teaching and mentoring high school and elementary school teachers who were preparing to become principals. She was a firm believer in mentoring students and teachers. This scholarship is intended to promote and continue her legacy through mentoring.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

1. Be a current freshman, sophomore or junior student in good standing at Resurrection College Prep High School and enrolled for the following school year.
2. Demonstrate financial need.*
3. Consistently provide tutorial or mentoring services to other students.
4. Continue mentoring during the school year for which the scholarship is awarded.
5. Preference will be given to students mentoring/tutoring in math, but all student mentors are encouraged to apply.

*Need will be assessed by the FACTS Student Aid Application

- ✓ The Dr. Chris Kelly Student Mentor Scholarship is a one-time award.
- ✓ One scholarship is awarded annually in the amount of \$2,000.
- ✓ Scholarship will be forfeited if recipient does not complete the academic year for which it is awarded.
