Eligibility

Applicants must:

1. Be a current freshman, sophomore, or junior student in good standing at Resurrection College Prep High School and enrolled for the following school year.
2. Demonstrate financial need.*
3. Be a current participant in Journalism at Resurrection as a member of the Res Banner or Allegiance staff.

- ✓ The Patty Kusinski Smith Memorial Scholarship is a one-time award.
- ✓ One scholarship is awarded annually in the amount of \$2,000.
- ✓ Scholarship will be forfeited if recipient does not complete the academic year for which it is awarded.
