



The Sr. Mary Monica Hope Scholarship

This scholarship is in memory of former teacher and principal, Sr. Mary Monica Widelski, C.R. She served as Principal of Resurrection College Prep High School from 1968-1979. Each year, more and more families are in need of financial assistance to provide their daughters with the Resurrection College Prep High School experience.

Sr. M. Monica loved Resurrection and believed strongly in a Catholic single-gender education, especially for young women. She was the first in her family to attain a college degree and she was also a first generation U.S. citizen, serving as a great inspiration to her nieces and nephews.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

1. Be an incoming freshman or current freshman, sophomore, or junior student in good standing at Resurrection College Prep High School and enrolled for the following school year.
2. Demonstrate financial need.*
3. Believe a Catholic, single-gender education is important to their future.
4. Incoming freshman applicants must provide a letter of recommendation from their parish pastor or grade school principal.

- ✓ Number and amount of scholarships vary based on student need and availability
- ✓ Scholarship will be forfeited if recipient does not complete the academic year for which it is awarded.
