

The Thomasetta Czajkowski Solak '58 Scholarship

This scholarship is dedicated to the memory of Thomasetta (Tomi) Czajkowski Solak, who was a prolific painter. It was established by Tomi's family and friends to help young women further their talents in art, leadership, and self-expression.

Thomasetta lived passionately and loved deeply. A long-time student of Resurrection Academy and a 1958 graduate of Resurrection High School, she provided support to those in need, always displaying unwavering strength which was deeply rooted in her faith, love, and devotion for her family and friends. She was a dedicated Marine wife and devoted mother to her children. She loved to travel, learn, cook, entertain, draw, and paint. In her early years, she attended the Chicago Art Institute with her father and in retirement painted creatively. While raising and sending her four children to college, she earned her Bachelor of Psychology degree from George Mason University.

Thomasetta delighted in showering gifts on those she loved; each one chosen or often made with care. She was generous in sharing her time, talents, treasure, her listening ear and advice, and her love.
