The entire school community was especially blessed to have Archbishop William Gregory celebrate our first school Mass of the year in the new center, and to celebrate the installation of President Rick Wood.

Joining the upper and lower campuses, the building quickly became the hub for all school events and the main location for Homecoming events, and where prospective students and families are greeted before a campus tour.

In mid-September, during a donor appreciation event and ribbon-cutting ceremony, we celebrated the opening of the Donnie Williams Center with the donors, the St. Mary's Ryken Board of Directors and friends of St. Mary's Ryken who made this multipurpose center a reality. More than 100 students are participating in a yoga class during the first semester of the 2019–20 school year. Yoga classes also are offered to staff one morning and one afternoon each week.



The athletic training room is an advanced space for athletic training classes, and sports medicine and recovery for over 350 student-athletes.



The strength and conditioning room is a space that students and faculty are proud to use. With college-level equipment and training facilities, student-athletes are better prepared for the competitive nature of the Washington Catholic Athletic Conference. Staff-only open gym hours are available in the morning and afternoons on varying days throughout the week.

## DISTINGUISHED 2019 ALUMNA OF THE YEAR

St. Mary's Ryken recognizes Anne Bowes Taylor (SMA '81) as Alumna of the Year for her outstanding service to the community, her determination and commitment to improving the quality of life of others and for exemplifying the ideals and character of a St. Mary's Ryken alumnus.

Anne is a lifelong resident of St. Mary's County, raised with six siblings in the Tall Timbers area. Anne's parents, Robert and Patricia Bowes, instilled in their children the core values of the Catholic faith: family, honesty, integrity and hard work. These values were at the forefront of their lives.

It was a somewhat idyllic childhood filled with Sunday Mass, playing with siblings, weekly chores and nightly dinners (always with dessert) and focused on education. Love and respect for one another were always at the center of family life, which her parents showed each other and each of their seven children.

"My parents sacrificed significantly to ensure that I and my six siblings were able to attend Catholic school. First, at Little Flower, and then Ryken High School, St. Mary's Academy, and/or St. Mary's Ryken," Anne said. "My brothers, sister and I grew up watching our parents spend a great deal of their time volunteering at these schools to ensure their continued success. They did this, not just for our benefit, but for the benefit of the community and those to come later." They led by example, and Anne has carried that same value in her own family life.

Anne met her husband, Mark Taylor, in her sophomore year of high school. He asked her out to the Ryken Homecoming dance on "the hill" at Ryken after a soccer game. That "yes" has led to a lifetime of happiness—they've been married for 36 years and counting—and to the joining of two of the largest legacy families at SMR (Bowes and Taylor).

Anne was a focused and hard-working student at St. Mary's Academy, but she also has a fun side as demonstrated through her four years as a cheerleader and the friends she loved to hang out with, many of whom are still in her life today. She graduated in 1981 and was the valedictorian of her class. She went to college at Virginia Tech until she married Mark and then graduated from the University of Texas at Arlington in 1985 with a degree in electrical engineering. Anne has enjoyed an accomplished career as an engineer in a male-dominated field since the mid-'80s, pioneering a path for herself, and mentoring other women and engineers along the way. Moreover, for a woman who has had tremendous success in her career, she will still tell you that her four caring, smart, beautiful and successful

daughters are her greatest accomplishment in life. "They make me so proud to be their mom, every single day."

When making the decision on where to send their girls to school, there was no doubt that Anne and Mark would give them the same benefits of a Catholic education that they had received. "When our oldest, Erin, started at Little Flower, I followed my parents' example, as I didn't know any different; I saw volunteering as part of the 'deal.' That is just what I thought you were required to do. However, I quickly found volunteering was not a duty, it was a gift, and it was a blessing. I have benefited tremendously from the experience gained and friendships made while volunteering. In the end, I can honestly say, I've received so much more in return than I ever gave."

"It is my sincere hope that my grandchildren will be able to attend one of our local Catholic elementary schools and St. Mary's Ryken. I also believe that this will only be the case if our community continues to give of their time and talent to these schools to ensure their continued existence and success. I hope that in some small way I have set an example for others on the importance of volunteering and the joy that comes in the service of others."

Anne still works part-time at J.F. Taylor Inc., where she and Mark had incredible

careers; she and Mark have entered a new role in life that fills them with unimaginable joy—being grandparents! Whether it is traveling to North Carolina or locally, their grandchildren have been a true blessing in their lives. They have three grandchildren currently and two more due in the coming months.

Anne has been guided in her life by the faith and compassion instilled in her by her parents and strengthened by her unity with her husband, Mark. When asked who has inspired her outside of her family, it is no wonder those influences are two nuns. First, Sister Sara Ann Abell from St. Mary's Academy — not only a wonderful teacher but also someone who became a friend and mentor in her life after graduation. "Sister Sara Ann visited the hospital every day

to offer communion to those Catholics who wished to receive it. I was fortunate that she visited me and provided me Holy Communion when each of my daughters was born at St. Mary's Hospital; what a blessing to share that experience with her."

Anne never met her second inspiration, but we all know of Mother Teresa. One of Mother Teresa's famous quotes that hangs in the children's house in Calcutta is a daily reminder to Anne on what is important in life, and she has it pinned to the bulletin board above her desk at work. The quote is "Do Good Anyway." Anne shares, "Within this famous quote there are many phrases that I try to live by, but most appropriate for my message to all who give of their precious time to volunteer: 'The good you do today, people will often forget tomorrow, DO GOOD

## A SERVANT OF JESUS — A LIVING LEGACY: SISTER SARA ANN ABELL

Helping educate people was the focus of Sister Sara Ann's 84 years as a Sister of Charity. Like her mother before her, and many of her siblings, Sara Cecelia Abell attended St. Mary's Academy, which was run by the Sisters of Charity of Nazareth. After graduating in 1930, she entered their convent at the age of 18. Two of her sisters later followed.

There in Kentucky, she earned her undergraduate degree in social sciences from Spalding College, and later, two masters degrees: one in history from Catholic University of America, and another in religious education from Spalding.

In her years as an educator, she served as a high school principal and an administrator, and taught at the high school and college levels in several states, including Kentucky, Maryland, Tennessee, Ohio and North Carolina. Sister Sara Ann studied journalism at Seton Hall University in New Jersey and sponsored high school newspapers and yearbooks at six of the schools in which she taught. She was a member of the Catholic Historical Society, Quill and Scroll journalism honor society, and several

religious and charitable societies. Added to all that, she was a certified catechist. And for all of this, she never took a salary!

Having taught throughout the country, she returned to Southern Maryland in 1972 to, as she put it, "look in on my mother, who was getting older," and to teach at St. Mary's Academy.

Back in St. Mary's County, Sister Sara Ann did not take it easy. She started a service program for St. Mary's Academy seniors in 1980 so they could practice putting their faith into action, visiting nursing homes, working in homes for the developmentally disabled and working with less fortunate people in a variety of ways.

When the academy closed in 1981, she wanted the program to continue. With donations from the United Way, civic groups and private individuals, Sister Sara Ann established the Literacy Council and served as its first president. Thousands of people have learned to read thanks to the efforts of Sister Sara Ann and her tutors. Their work continues today and is a marvelous testament to Sister Sara Ann, who was "*a teacher always*."

Sister Sara Ann was not just an ordinary teacher — she was a teacher who was committed to teach as Jesus did! She went out and met people in need, ministering to their spiritual needs by taking the Blessed Sacrament to folks in the hospital tirelessly. She ministered to their physical needs by carrying food and gifts to homes around the county, making Christmas special for many families and often arriving last at her own family's Christmas dinner.

Sister Sara Ann ministered to people's intellectual needs as an instructor, as a catechist, and through the work of her beloved Literacy Council. At the age of 102, Sister Sara Ann died at the Sisters of Charity of Nazareth home in Louisville, Kentucky, on Jan. 24, 2015. Now, her

legacy of teaching and ministering will continue through the newly established Sister Sara Ann Abell Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship will benefit students in need who also demonstrate a passion and commitment to serving others.

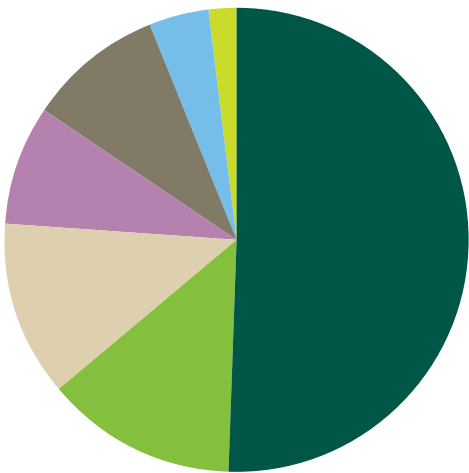
