

Program Structure

After-School Sports (JA-M2)

i.e. 'Developmental Sports'

- Typically occurs between 3-4pm each day;
- Designed to provide positive, introductory experiences in a variety of sports;
- Current offerings include gymnastics, taekwondo, dance, soccer, basketball, tennis, badminton, flag rugby and intramurals;
- Partners include Alvin Ailey Dance Theater, Manhattan Kickers FC and Play Rugby USA.

Interscholastic Sports (M3-T4)

i.e. 'Competitive Sports'

- Typically occurs between 3-7pm each day;
- Comprised of competitive Middle School, Junior Varsity and Varsity teams;
- Involves 'trying out' process, team selection, frequent practices, travel to/from external venues;
- Competition with other NYCAL (New York City Athletic League) schools.

- **7 New Teams!**

(Girls Middle School Volleyball 'White' (Fall); Boys Middle School Soccer 'White' (Fall); Girls Varsity Tennis (Fall); Girls Middle School Basketball 'White' (Winter); Boys Middle School Basketball 'White' (Winter); Boys Middle School Volleyball (Spring); Coed Varsity Ultimate Frisbee (Spring).

- **Established relationship with NYC Parks Department;**
- **Secured access to fields for UNIS Queens campus;**
- **Introduced changes to NYCAL Track and Field timing system;**
- **Recorded record tryout numbers (over 300) and sign-ups for after-school sport (235);**
- **Organized Athletics 'Kick-off' event for Middle School athletes (with guest speaker);**
- **Refined team selection process, including request for clear criteria and rationale from coaching staff;**
- **Introduced intramural programs in Girls JV soccer and Coed Badminton;**
- **Introduced new Athletic Training 'Appointments' System for UNIS Athletes.**

Sports Medicine

Pre-2016

- No 'in-house' Athletic Trainer = primarily 'off-site' treatment + consultations

2016

- In-house Athletic Trainer appointed = continuity of care + network of orthopedic specialists.

2017

- Hydrocollator added

2018

- Normatec recovery system added
- Powerplay unit added

2019

- Due to demand of treatment a larger hydrocollator unit was purchased
- Appointment system added: eapergis.youcanbook.me
- SportsWare software added

Final Thoughts

Current priorities include:

- a) identifying continued opportunities for expansion;
- b) maintaining recruitment of high-quality coaches;
- c) promoting the UNIS Athletics Philosophy (see next slide) to students, coaches, parents, and the school community.
