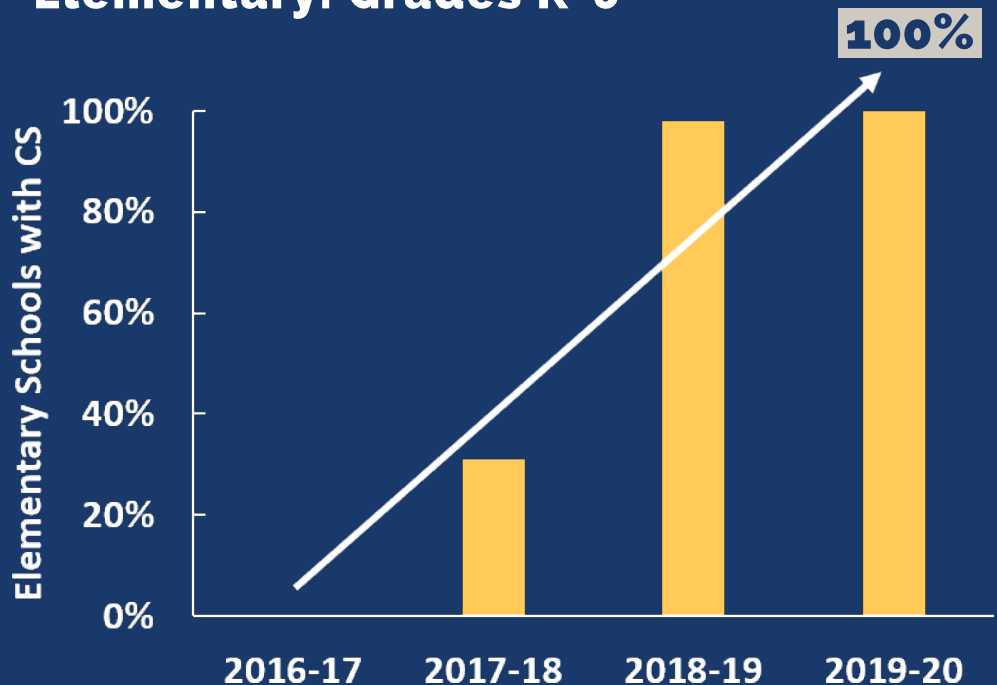
Computer Science

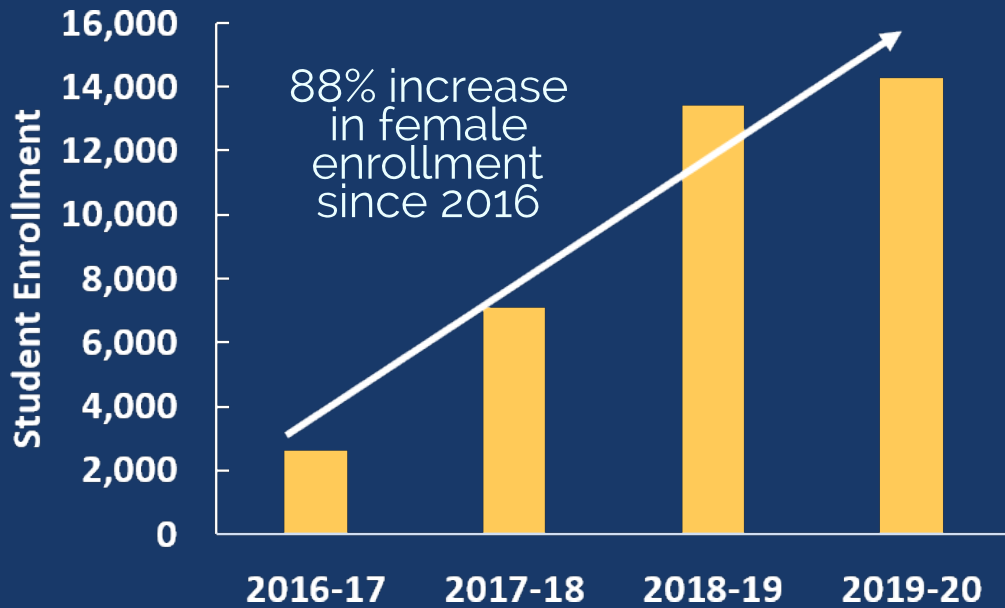
Elementary: Grades K-6

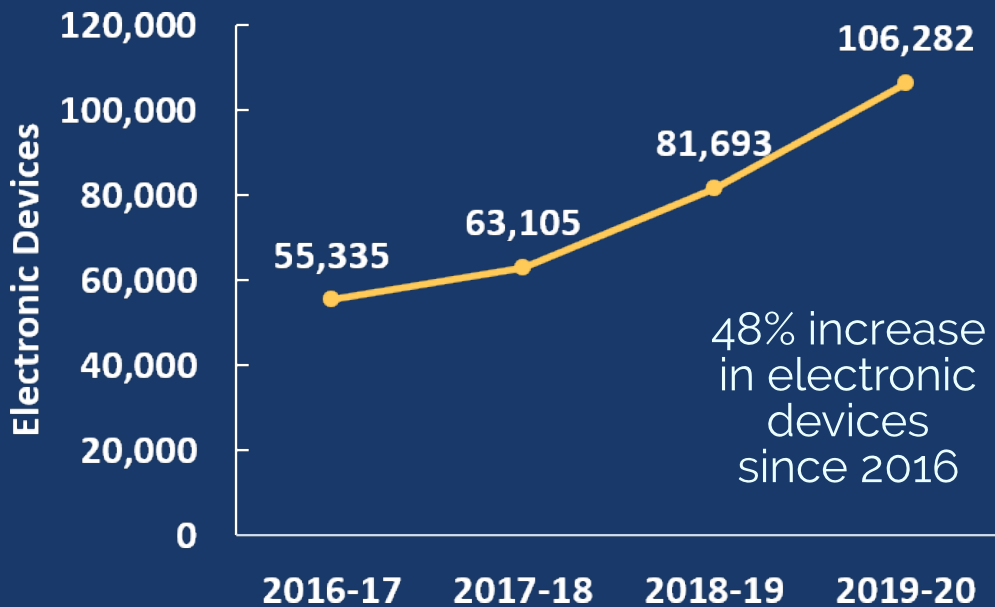
Secondary: Grades 7-12
