Dear Families,

The state of Tennessee requires various screenings for students in grades PreK, K, 2, 4, 6, 8, and in the Lifetime Wellness classes at Maryville Junior High School. The Tennessee Department of Education's Student Health Report Card is attached with your student's health screening results. As indicated in the attached sheet, one screening result falls in the recommended range for a physician referral. *These results are not diagnostic in nature and do not necessarily reflect a health problem for your child. Only a health care provider can make a diagnosis.*

Please note that only students in kindergarten were screened for color vision. Only students in 6th grade were screened for scoliosis. If your student is in the other grades please disregard the color and scoliosis screening results.

If you need health-related advice, please consult your child's health care provider.
