## Casual Sports Coaches

### Expressions of Interest for 2020 School Year

Shelford Girls' Grammar is seeking expressions of interest from Casual Sports Coaches, to assist in the development and performance of the School's sporting teams. Shelford is a member school of Girls Sport Victoria (GSV) and coaching positions are offered on a casual basis, based on the GSV fixture and the School's carnival and house sport program. Sports that Shelford participate in across the School year include softball, hockey, soccer, badminton, volleyball, basketball, cricket, track and field, and cross country.

Sports coaches report to the Head of Sport, and are based between the School's Caulfield campus and other venues based on the GSV fixture. Sports coaches are responsible for providing quality coaching services to the students of the School. Specific responsibilities of the role include, but are not limited to, the planning and implementation of training sessions, preparation for their respective assigned sport and teams, and mentoring and developing the attributes of all students in their team. Training sessions occur before or after School, with competitions occurring after School hours based on the GSV fixtures.

The successful candidates will possess:

- Experience in sports coaching at a senior school level (preferred but not essential)
- Relevant coaching qualifications (preferred but not essential)
- First Aid and Anaphylaxis Management Qualifications (or be willing to obtain)
- A current Working with Children Check (or be willing to obtain)
- Victorian Driver's Licence (Heavy Vehicle) (not essential)
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills
- Ability to work individually and as part of a team
- A strong sense of commitment, reliability and professional responsibility
