1. Administrative Staff Organization

C. Job Descriptions

(1) Superintendent of Schools

The Board of Education will elect and fix the terms of office and salary of a Superintendent who serves as the chief executive officer of the Board and has authority and responsibility for the supervision of the school system.

The Board shall provide a written contract of employment which includes salary, benefits, job description and term of office of the Superintendent. The job description will be subject to review in conjunction with contract inception and/or renewal.

At the end of the school year, the Board will evaluate the Superintendent in accordance with guidelines and criteria mutually determined and agreed upon by both the Board and the Superintendent at the beginning of the school year.
