A. Schedules

(4) Emergencies and Disaster Preparedness

(a) Fire

A fire drill shall be held at least once a month in each building. Each building principal shall prepare a definite fire emergency plan, and furnish to all teachers and students information as to route and manner of exit. Fire drills shall be planned in such a way as to accomplish the evacuation of school buildings in the shortest possible time and in the most efficient and orderly fashion.

Principals shall keep a record of all fire drills held in their schools, stating the date the drill was held and the time required for evacuation of the building. They shall furnish such reports to the Superintendent or his/her designee.
