0. Role of Board and Members (Powers, Purposes, Duties)

G. Board-Related Responsibilities

In order to ensure that its operations support the schools in providing all students with a high quality education, the Suffield Board of Education shall:

1. Employ an able and qualified Superintendent to effectively carry out the goals and objectives of the Board. Conduct an annual evaluation of the superintendent.
2. Formulate Board policies which best serve the educational interests of students and provide the Superintendent with sufficient and adequate guidelines for monitoring.
3. Develop, adopt and monitor a fiscally responsible annual budget balancing education needs against available resources.
4. Work closely with the community to ensure that Board actions and performance reflect the concerns and aspirations of the community.
5. Keep informed of the future education needs of the town, state and nation.
6. Evaluate on an annual basis the Board's performance in relation to these responsibilities, as well as any set goals.
