Eanes ISD is a small urban school district located in the areas of West Lake Hills, Rollingwood and west Austin. We are committed to excellence in academics, extracurriculars and co-curriculars, preparing students for life-long success through high-quality instruction and access to a variety of opportunities and experiences.

Eanes ISD serves approximately 7,700 students in nine schools: five elementary schools grades K-5, two middle schools grades 6-8, and one high school grades 9-12. The District also boasts an Adult Transition Services (ATS) campus for special education students who have completed state-mandated high school graduation requirements.



Meeting each student's needs is paramount in Eanes ISD. A comprehensive curriculum and a variety of enrichment opportunities are offered to Eanes ISD's students, including proudly serving as a 1:1 mobile device district since 2011 and a Business Incubator program for Westlake students.

Eanes ISD students score well on the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) and American College Test (ACT), consistently exceeding the state and national averages. Approximately 99 percent of Eanes ISD's graduates are accepted into college.

As the flagship college prepatory high school, Westlake High School holds a national reputation for excellence, and is included on the nation's best high school lists by Niche and U.S. News.

Enrollment


Children who will be 5 years old on or before Sept. 1, 2025, are eligible to begin Kindergarten in Fall of 2025.

Families will need the following documents to enroll:


- Child's birth certificate (original document must be presented at your child's campus)
- Child's Social Security card (preferred, but optional)
- Child's immunization record
- Parent or Guardian valid driver's license indicating a correct, current address in the District
- Family's proof of residency, including (1) current, signed lease, deed or contract or most recent tax receipt; and (2) a current utility bill for the property in question in parent's name

Documents can be submitted electronically. To prepare, make sure each document is a separate file. Recommended file types: .pdf, .jpg or .doc. Limit 10 MB max file size per document. If you do upload the documents electronically, we still need you to bring your child's original birth certificate to your child's campus.


