Student Responsibilities:

- ❑ **FOCUS ON NEXT YEAR COURSE REQUESTS!!**
- ❑ **Pay attention to YOUR graduation requirements**
- ❑ **Request 15 classes per year (not including Alternates)**
- ❑ **Add 5 Alternates (back up courses)**
- ❑ **ALL students must register regardless of next years intent (moving, PSEO etc)**

Graduation Requirements

You are responsible to know your credit status!

❑ To graduate you must have credits total:

57 Credits

- ❑ 8 English credits
- ❑ 8 Social Studies credits
- ❑ 7 Science credits
- ❑ 5 Math credits (2 tri's Geometry, 2 tri's Alg. 2, 1 tri Prob/Stats)
- ❑ 2 Physical Education credits
- ❑ 1 Futures Prep credit (unless you transferred here)
- ❑ 1 Health credit
- ❑ 2 Art Credits
- ❑ 1 CTE Credit (ONLY for Class of 2023 and beyond)
- ❑ 22-23 Elective credits (optional **Activity Credit**)

4-Year College Requirements

Minimum requirements to get into a 4-year college:

- ❑ Complete all SFHS Requirements
- ❑ **Some colleges (example: U of M) looks for 4 years of Math completed**
- ❑ **World Language: 2 years of the same language (recommended)**

Please review the pin number with your student prior to the start of school. The meal account balance is also displayed in the Campus Portal "Nutritional Services tab." Please be sure your child has a positive meal account balance for the school year. Parents may add funds to meal accounts at your school's open house. Additionally, online payments can be made through FeePay website <https://district15.feepay.com> or the PayPams website www.PayPams.com; a transaction fee will be charged to the user for each transaction. Payments can also be made by check or cash at the school. Students must have enough funds in their accounts to be eligible to purchase individual milk, extras and ala carte items. The collections process has been approved for negative meal debt. Those families that can pay, should keep their student's meal account positive to avoid meal debt being turned over to collections. Financial assistance is available to help pay for meals, and many families in this district will qualify. To find out if your family qualifies, please consider filling out an application for [Free and Reduced Price Lunch](#) which will give your family access to free meals. For example, a family of four with two adults and two school children will qualify if gross earnings (before taxes and deductions) is less than \$44,950. This is just one example, please visit www.isd15.org/nutrition for more information. Families receiving free meals must reapply each year. Please apply early to receive full benefits. Watch for the 2016-17 school year Educational Benefits form in the August Courier, as well as a link on the Campus Portal, or call 763-753-7015 for more information. 


