BASIC INFORMATION

- Brewster Academy Summer School, also known as BASS, is a four-week program for children ages 13 to 17
- Limited to 50 students
- Located in Wolfeboro, New Hampshire, an idyllic resort community on Lake Winnepesaukee
- Summer temperatures typically range 70-85 F (21-29 C)

WHY DO STUDENTS ATTEND BASS?

- Work and play—BASS has a unique combination of academics and adventure recreation
- Respect—The BASS staff recognize that each student has his/her own learning style.
- Faculty—Professional teachers and staff run the program.
- Hands-on learning—The BASS environment focuses on building skills in and out of the classroom.
- Small class sizes—There is plenty of individualized attention.
- Location—Wolfeboro is a small summer resort town in central New Hampshire, just two hours north of Boston. The campus has a half-mile of lakefront on picturesque Lake Winnepesaukee. Downtown is just a five-minute walk from campus!
- Sense of community—whether a student has come to BASS to improve their English skills, develop academically, or experience a boarding school environment, students become quick friends here.
- Community living—Students live in small dormitories, typically seven to 12 students in each. There are Americans and international students in double or triple rooms to give a sense of global community. Dorm parents live in the dormitory with the students and serve as mentors for community living.
- Diversity—BASS participants get to meet students from all over the world.
