Scholarships are awarded to exceptional students able to demonstrate expertise in the available scholarship categories. All awards are merit-based and there is no guarantee that scholarships will be awarded for each category. Applicants are required to submit completed documentation and be prepared to showcase their talents before a panel.

All applicants must be in good standing, maintain a minimum mark of 5 (or 6 for an Academic Scholarship), and be participating in applicable events/programs in order to maintain eligibility for their scholarships.

The application deadline is 3.00 PM (email submission) on January 31, 2020; no late applications will be considered. Decisions will be made on March 27, 2020. Recipients will receive financial awards based upon panelist input as well as access to Quest support as appropriate and based upon availability.

Scholarships are awarded to current upper school students enrolled at Dwight for the following categories (please select only one to apply for):

Academic

Applicants must be great all-around students who personify the IB Attitudes, Learner Profile, and Dwight School Seoul Mission and Philosophy AND demonstrate exceptional academic abilities by maintaining an average mark of 6 in course work.

Athletic

Applicants must exemplify good sportsmanship, including attitude toward team members, coaches, equipment, officials and spectators. Applicants must also demonstrate a proven record of outstanding athleticism and will represent Dwight in two full seasons on a Varsity Team. The Dwight Athletic Director will verify each applicant's records for participation.

Performing and Creative Arts (Drama, Film, Music, Visual Arts)

Applicants must perform two pieces or provide a portfolio of works. Applicants may be required to exhibit work in the Dwight Gallery or participate in Dwight School Seoul performances.

Technology (Robotics, Programming, Animation, Software)

Applicants must demonstrate outstanding knowledge in a selected area and provide samples of works completed.
