Scholarships are awarded to exceptional students able to demonstrate expertise in the available scholarship categories (varsity grade 8+ volleyball and basketball; grade 6-11 robotics; music - jazz, band, woodwind, voice; grade 6+ academic IB excellence). All awards are full and/or merit-based and there is no guarantee that scholarships will be awarded for each category. Applicants are required to submit completed documentation and be prepared to showcase their talents before a panel.

All applicants must be in good standing, maintain good academic standing (IB average 5, or for an IB academic scholarship an IB average of 6), and participate in events/programs in order to maintain eligibility for their scholarships.

The application deadline is at 3.00 PM, January 31, 2020; no late applications will be considered. Decisions will be made on March 27. Recipients will receive financial awards based upon panelist input and based upon availability. Scholarships are awarded to new upper school students who will enroll at Dwight for the following categories (please select only one to apply for):

IB Academic Excellence

- Demonstrate exceptional academic ability
- Maintaining an average of 6 on the second-semester report
- A balanced student who models the attributes of the IB Learner Profile and lives the Dwight School Mission 'to ignite the spark of genius'

Varsity Basketball and Volleyball (grade 8)*

- Compete in two varsity seasons during the academic year
- The student must have a proven record of outstanding athleticism while exemplifying good sportsmanship, including attitude toward team members, coaches, officials, and spectators at current and/or previous schools

Performing Arts (Music)

- Successful students will be self-driven leaders and promote music interests whole school
- Successful students will be required to exhibit their talents on behalf of Dwight, including, but not limited to: School Production, Dwight International Music Festival, KIMEA, AMIE and ISTA events, and other Dwight sponsored occasions (ie BCCK, ANZA, Embassy events)

Technology (Robotics, Programming, Animation, Software) - grade 6+

- Demonstrate knowledge, understanding, and skills in the selected area.
- Provide evidence of work completed that demonstrates knowledge and/or skills that benefit the community
