FROM SCHOOL NURSE:

We have started the season for Influenza and are asking parents for their help as the School Nurses along with the Dept of Health participate in the State of Connecticut Influenza Surveillance program.

When calling your child out sick in dismissal manager, please indicate the presence of flu like symptoms:

- Sudden onset of fever (over 100 F or 37.7 C)
- Cough and/or sore throat
- Headaches and/or body aches
- Fatigue

If your child tests positive for Influenza, we follow the 5-day guideline that states to **keep your child home a minimum of 5 days after diagnosis** and to bring a doctor note. Please see attached for more information on Influenza.
