Classroom Management: Monitor youth and afterschool spaces to ensure safe participation.

Collaboration and Communication: Work collaboratively and communicate courteously and effectively with teaching team, parents, students and the public.

Professional Development: Obtain 18 clock hours of professional development through attendance at workshops, seminars, trainings and conferences.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School Diploma or GED
- Minimum 18 years of age.
- At least 1 year experience working with elementary school age children, ages 5 to 12; qualifying education, or a combination of experience and qualifying education.
- Ability to supervise groups of children, ages 5-12
- Ability to work with passion, energy and enthusiasm

- Ability to communicate clearly and positively with both children and adults
- Ability to work under pressure in noisy and often chaotic environments
- Ability to successfully enroll in the Oregon Central Background Registry
